I, SI Rakesh Debnath, of Ambari-Falakata OP under NJP Ps, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby submit this written complaint to the effect that, on 18.01.2022 at 14.25 hrs, received specific reliable source information that, one Oil tanker will come at Bandhunagar more via N.H 31D coming from Assam to Bihar with huge quantity of Ganja for disposing the same for their wrongful gain. The matter has been diarized in GD vide Ambari-Falakata OP GDE No-638 dated 18.01.2022. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C, Ambari-Falakata Out Post, SPC in writing a letter to him and expressed the entire information. At 14.35 hrs as per his kind direction myself along with ASI Kajal Chakraborty, ASI Sailendra Singh, C/505 Tapash Dutta, C/975 Swarup Basak, C/876 Ram Ch. Orawn and C/V-001 Jaychand Roy all of Ambari-Falakata Out Post, SPC left for Bandhunagar More to verify the veracity of the information vide M.C.C No. 136/22 Dt. 18.01.2022 which refers to Ambari-Falakata OP GDE No. 639 Dt. 18.01.2022 by Govt. Vehicle bearing No. WB 62 A/7050 driven by Baban Prasad

At the time of departure from Out Post, I took envelopes, white papers, sealing wax, gum, seal, etc. At about 14.55 hrs we reached at Bandhunagar more and parked the vehicle at considerable distance of approx. 100 mtrs and on foot started proceeding towards Bandhunagar More and meanwhile called two independent witnesses namely; (1) Abhijit Majumdar S/o Lt. Ashim Majumdar Of Ambari-Falakata, P.o-Kamarvita, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri and (2) Subhas Sarkar S/o Lt. Naraynar Sarkar of 9 No. Colony, P.o-Kamarvita, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri and disclosed our identity and
