In producing herewith 04 (four) arrested accused persons who disclosed their identity as (i) Makhan Sadhu (59 yrs), s/o - Lt. Narottam Sadhu of 18 No Milanpally, PS - NJP, Dist - Jalpaiguri (ii) Bikash Roy (22 yrs), s/o - Prasannya Roy of South Ektiasal near Naba Jyoti Club, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist - Jalpaiguri (iii) Prasenjit Roy (22 yrs), s/o - Sunil Roy of Station Para, Lataguri, PS- Malbazar, Dist - Jalpaiguri (iv) Dharujyoti Saha (25 yrs), s/o - Dilip Saha of -Do-.

I, SI Kamal Sarkar of Milanpally OP under NJP PS /SPC do here by lodge this written complaint against the above noted 04 (four) arrested accused persons to the effect that while on performing special naka duty myself along with officer and forces had been to Teesta Barrage under Milanpally OP at 19:05 hrs and found that the above noted persons are gathered there without any reason and found them without wearing mask. Thereby making unnecessary gathering at Teesta Barrage under Milanpally OP. On being asked the above noted persons stated before me that they were well aware of West Bengal Govt. Order regarding pandemic situation of COVID 19 and new COVID 19 variant Omicron and wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation.

They all violated the west Bengal Govt Order No - 753/XVII - ISS/2M-22/2020, Dated - 02.01.22. Hence I arrested them U/S - 41 Cr.P.C in c/w the case under proper memo of arrest duly signed by them in presence of witnesses.

Now I request you for starting a specific case U/S-188/269/270 IPC r/w Sec 51(b) of Disaster Management Act 2005 against the above noted accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
