In producing herewith 05 (Five) arrested accused persons U/s 41 Cr.P.C who disclosed their identity as (1) Vivekananda Roy (21yrs) S/o. Khagendra Nath Roy of Bhabanipur , PS. Kaliaganj, Dist-Uttar Dinajpur (2) Pintu Roy (34 yrs) S/o. Kaben Ch. Roy of Laxmijote, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (3) Biswajit Biswas (326 yrs) S/o. Late Shanti Charan Biswas , of Jorepokhri More, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (4) Pradip Biswas (21yrs), S/o Kartik Biswas of Surya Sen Colony, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (5) Parotosh Roy (22 yrs), S/o. Asaru Roy of Rangalivita , PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri.

I, ASI Pradip Kumar Sarkar of New Jalpaiguri Police Station, SPC do here by lodged this written complaint against the above noted persons to the effect that today (27/01/22) in between 17:15 Hrs and 17:55 Hrs in course of performing evening QRT mobile duty I along with force went Gate Bazar area ,PS- NJP , Jalpaiguri and found (1) Vivekananda Roy (21yrs) S/o. Khagendra Nath Roy of Bhabanipur , PS. Kaliaganj, Dist-Uttar Dinajpur (2) Pintu Roy (34 yrs) S/o. Kaben Ch. Roy of Laxmijote, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (3) Biswajit Biswas (326 yrs) S/o. Late Shanti Charan Biswas , of Jorepokhri More, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (4) Pradip Biswas (21yrs), S/o Kartik Biswas of Surya Sen Colony, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri (5) Parotosh Roy (22 yrs), S/o. Asaru Roy of Rangalivita , PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri were gathered there without any reason and found them without wearing mask and also making unnecessary gathering at Gate Bazar area. On interrogation they also stated that they were well aware of Govt. order regarding pandemic situations and wearing of facemasks was mandatory in public places in the current pandemic situation.

They all are violated the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2029 Dtd. 02/01/2022 regarding pandemic situations.. Hence, I arrested them under proper memo of arrest in between 17:15 Hrs and 17:55 Hrs and duly signed by them in presence of witnesses and inform the ground of arrest.

Hence, I, request you for starting a specific case U/S 188/269/270 IPC r/w sec 51 (b) of disaster Management Act.2005 against the above noted accused persons and arrange proper investigation of the case.
