employees named Kallol Majumder has disappeared.

had given him and his wife 'Riya Majumder' a sum of Rupees
Eighty five thousand. which was to be deposited in the bank
account in Bank of Baroda. He had taken the scooter with number
WB 74 W 1193, which is my father's. I tried calling Kallol after
half an hour where I found his number switched off. Fortunately,
I found Riya's number dialling and somehow found her in
front of Payal Cinema Hall. Somehow convinced her to come to
my office. His Aadhar card number is 9407 6350 2583.
His residence as per his wife is South Bharat Nagar, near Samnanay
Welfare - Arniya Villa. The copy of Aadhar card has been attached.

The person along with the Scooty has not been found yet.
We have found in various cases where Bhaktinagar Police
department has successfully solved missing people. Please
be kind to help me.
