Sir, With due respect I Sri Anupam Gupta S/o Sri Binshidhar Prasad resident of Vidasagar Pally, Khalpara, P.O & P.S - Siliguri, District - Darjeeling would like to inform you that Upasana Devi Gupta is my elder sister and her marriage was solemnized on 7 - 2 - 2007 with Sri Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta S/o Late Kanhaiya Lal Gupta of Gaddi Khan, P.O & P.S & Dist - Darjeeling according to Hindu rites and customs at Rishi Bhawan, Burdwan Road, Siliguri, District - Darjeeling and as per demand every thing has been given to Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta towards dowry but he was never been satisfied. After marriage my sister Upasana Devi Gupta has started her matrimonial life with Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta at Darjeeling and out of wed lock my sister became the mother of one child namely Anuska Prasad present aged about 12 years. Though long years back the marriage was solemnized but the lust of demand of money by Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta was not ended and to achieve his goal has started forcing her to ask for partition in her paternal property. Be it mention here that the husband of my sister is a drug addicted men and off and on used to ask money for his addition. Since the day of her marriage she was subjected of mental and physical torture from the end of her husband and on several times tried to strangulate her and my sister used to narrate the facts of the torture of her husband to my mother and several times we have negotiated the matter in between them with intention that both can lead their marital life. Be it mention here that subsequent the said Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta alongwith my sister and daughter have shifted to Matigara and presently they have started residing in the rented house at Dev Kunj, Phani Bhusan Vidyapith Road, near Ram Takur Mandir, Milanpally, P.O & P.S - Siliguri, District - Darjeeling and my another sister namely Urmila Gupta is also residing in the said building as tenant.

Yesterday i.e. on 26 - 2 - 2022 on the issue of drug, quarrel took place in between both of them and out of fear my niece i.e. the daughter of my sister Anuska Prasad at about 10 a.m went in the adjacent flat of my another sister namely Urmila Gupta to avoid the quarrel of her parent in the mean time at about 2.30 p.m. the husband of my sister locked the door of the flat from inside and poured keroson Oil upon my sister and burnt her and caught hold her so that she can not open the door of the rented flat. After hearing the screaming of my sister Upasna Devi Prasad when my another sister Urmila Gupta and niece have asked to open the door but Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta nether could he himself opened the door nor has allowed my sister to open the door and when my sister was completely burnt then Panch Ratan Gupta opened the door and my sister Urmila and niece Anuska find that my sister Upasana Devi Gupta was almost burnt and thereafter she was shifted to Siliguri Sadar Hospita but by seeing the

crucial condition of my sister, she was referred to North Bengal Medical College and hospital and presently she is fighting for her life and death.

The husband of my sister Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta as burnt my sister by pouring keroson oil to kill and presently her physical condition is so curious that she might not been survived.

So requesting you to investigate the matter and take necessary legal action against Panch Ratan Prasad Gupta for the interest of justice I could not lodge my complaint within time as because I was serious busy in hospital to save her life.
