Subject :- Written Complaint

Madam,

Today at about 10.30 PM when my wife Ratna Barman was at her parental Home at Jhankar More, Govt. Saw Mill Road, Adarsha Colony, Ward No. 4 of S.M.C., who is pregnant for more than 9 months, LMP was on 14/05/2021 and expected date of delivery is on 14/03/2022, suddenly 1) Md. Pappu, resident of Madrasa, Adarsha Colony, Ward No. 4 of S.M.C., 2) Md. Chanu, Rail Line, Shani Mandir, Adarsha Colony, Ward No. 4 of S.M.C., 3) Swapan Raim, son of Late Moinuddin, Jhankar More, Govt. Saw Mill Road, Adarsha Colony, Ward No. 4 of S.M.C., entered at that house and brutally beaten my wife to murder her and to prevent the foetus to born alive or to cause it to die after birth. She was fatally injured. She was immediately rushed to the Siliguri District Hospital where he was admitted and fighting with death where she was admitted only after bond was signed that Hospital would not take the responsibility of the foetus in case any untoward incident happens. Her condition is very serious. When my mother-in-law Kabita Barman, wife of Basanta Barman, Manti Barman, wife of Prasanta Barman, Pramila Barman, wife of Hemanta Barman, Suniti Barman, wife of Late Khirod Barman tried to save my wife the above named Md. Pappu, Md. Chanu and Swapan Raim beaten them brutally, caused brushes in their hands and molested them, torn their cloths, shattered their conch shell bangles and Pala. My brothers-in-law Jayanta Barman, Susanta Barman also received injuries while trying to save my wife.

My wife is fighting for her life at Hospital with her foetus.

Under the circumstances I request you to be kind enough to treat this complaint as FIR, arrest the above named culprits and take necessary legal actions against them.
