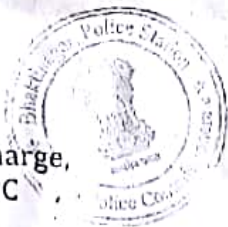

Respected Sir,

In producing herewith one Shaktiman Truck bearing Registration No. **WB 76 B-0551** Loaded with river bed material seized u/s 102 Cr.P.C under proper seizure list.

I beg to report that I, PSI Sailesh Subba of P.S Bhaktinagar, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint against the driver and owner of Truck, bearing No **WB 76 B-0551** and others to the effect that on 05.03.2022 I along with ASI Bhusan Ram Singh, C/783 S. Minj, C/ 843 Suman Basfore were performing night Mobile van duty vide MCC No. 112/22 dated 05.03.2022 in course of Van duty on 06.03.2022 at morning about 05.30 hrs morning I received a source information that one Truck bearing Registration No. **WB 76B-0551** loaded with illegal River Bed Material, pebbles is coming from Military Ghat and going towards Haiderpara. Accordingly, I shared the information with I/C Bhaktinagar P.S, SPC over telephone and as per his kind verbal direction, I along with my force had been to Check Post More, Sevoke Raod and placed a Naka there and started checking a vehicle coming from Military Ghat and at about 06.30 hrs one Truck was seen coming from the Military Ghat and as being indicated by the source, we tried to apprehended one Shaktiman Truck bearing Registration No. **WB 76 B-0551** but seeing the Police party the driver of said truck managed to flee away from truck. Seeing the activities of the driver, there was reason to believe that there was something illegal in the truck. Accordingly, I checked the vehicle and found the truck loaded with river bed sand. Further enquiry it could be learnt that the driver along with owner of the Truck in association with others of Military Ghats had procured the river bed materials, pebbles illegally from Military Ghat and carrying/transporting the same to Haiderpara for their wrongful gain without any valid documents. Hence under the circumstances, I seized the Shaktiman Truck bearing Registration No. **WB 76 B-0551** along with loaded pebbles u/s 102 Cr.P.C under proper seizure list. The whole process of search, seizure took place in between 06.50 hrs to 07.20 hrs.

Under the circumstances, I pray before you that kindly initiate a specific case against the driver of vehicle No. **WB 76 B-0551** and its owner and others under proper section of law and cause its investigation.
