Sir,

In producing herewith the following seized articles viz
1. One (01) improvised single-shatter fire arms, iron made, having total length about 35 cm with body, trigger, firing pin, barrel and butt, marked as Exhibit -A, seized under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses.

I, SI Rakesh Debnath of Ambari-Falakata OP, Ps-NJP, SPC do hereby submit this written complaint to the effect that, on 08.03.2022 at 12.15 hrs. while performing special mobile van duty received information from on duty officer of Ambari-Falakata OP that one fire arms has been found abandoned beside a culvert at Bhandarigachh and directed me to go there and verify the veracity of the information. This refers to Ambari-Falakata OP GDE no-183 dt. 08.03.2022. Accordingly myself along with the detailed force C/824 Satyaban Das & VP/014 Paritosh Roy all of Ambari OP, Ps-NJP, SPC proceeded towards Bhandarigachh to verify the veracity of the information. After reaching there I have found that a mob of local people assembled beside a culvert and after enquiry they have pointing out me towards the abandoned arms which was found lying on the ground beside a culvert. During enquiry it is learnt that the said arms is a country made improvised fire arms loaded with a round, made of iron, measuring total approx. 35 cm including barrel, body & butt. Therefore I informed the same to O/C, Amb-Fkt OP and seized the said arms & ammunition through proper seizure list duly signed by the witness namely (i) Samijuddin Ahmed S/o Lt. Md. Piyaruddin Bhandarigachh, P.o-Balaram, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri & (ii) C/824 Satyaban Das Of Ambari-Falakata OP, Ps-NJP, SPC and labelled the same. The seizure & label were made in between 13.05 hrs and 13.25 hrs.

In course of further enquiry it could be learnt from local people that on 05/03/2022 night at about 21.00 hrs after hearing hue & cry of a boy they came out from their houses and found that one person riding/plying a Toto Rickshaw dangerously in a very high speed and another person was following it by running behind it with hue & cry. In the mean time seeing the local people the said Toto rider left the Toto and fled away but the local people recognised him and disclose his name as Samir Majumdar S/o Haripada Majumdar of Akarigachh, Banavasha, P.o-Balaram, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri. Thereafter, they came to know from the another person that he is a actual Toto driver of the said Toto and his Toto was booked by the said Samir Majumdar from NJP to Gander More but on way he was forcefully trying to take away his Toto by showing fire arms but fortunately local people saved his Toto. It is also mentioned that the incident was happened at the same place where the said fire arms has been recovered and they also believed that this fire arms is belong to said Samir Majumdar which was used on that day.

Therefore, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be initiated under proper section of law against Samir Majumdar S/o Haripada Majumdar of Akarigachh, Banavasha, P.o-Balaram, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
