Sir,

In producing herewith one accused persons namely Rana Majumdar (29) s/o Late Anil Majumdar of Ashik Ghat road, Bidhyachakra Colony, Ward No. 44, PS. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri under custody and the following properties under seizure -

- 1] Twenty One (21) vials of NRX Buprenorphine injection I.P, LUPIGESIC each vials containing 2ml packed, labeled and marked as "Exhibit A" . Out of which one vials of NRX Buprenorphine injection I.P, LUPIGESIC taken from exhibit "A" as a sample and marked as "Exhibit A-1".
- 2] Twenty One (21) vials of Abott. Rx. Promethazine Hydrochloride Injection I.P, PHENERGAN each vials containing 2ml packed, labeled and marked as "Exhibit B". Out of which one vials Abott. Rx. Promethazine Hydrochloride Injection I.P taken as sample from "Exhibit- B" and marked as "Exhibit -B 1".
- 3] Twenty (20) vials of NRX Diazepam Injection I.P each vials containing 2ml packed, labeled and marked as "Exhibit C". Out of which one vials NRX Diazepam Injection I.P taken as sample from "Exhibit- C" and marked as "Exhibit -C 1".
- 4] One Black and Yellow mixed coloured TVS NTORQ Scooty bearing Registration No. WB 74 BA 4783.

Seized the above noted articles from the possession of accused Rana Majumdar (29) s/o late Anil Majumdar of Ashik Ghat road, Bidhyachakra Colony, Ward No. 44, PS. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri .

I, ASI Dipak Karmakar of Bhaktinagar PS/SPC do hereby lodge a written complaint against the above noted arrested accused person to the effect that on 14.03.2022 at around 19.50 I, received a secret source information that notorious drug peddler namely Bikash Mallik and Rana Majumdar of Dasrath Pally were carrying huge quantity of restricted Narcotics drugs and injection and roaming near TB Hospital under Bhaktinagar PS by Scooty bearing Reg No. WB 74 BA 4783 in order to deliver the same to their designed Customers. And if acted immediately they may be caught red handed. Accordingly, informed the matter before you and as per your kind instruction myself along with ASI Rabin Lama, Constable/374 Debraj Biswas and CVF/619 Sumit Kumar Roy and CVF /935 Biplab Roy of Bhaktinagar PS/SPC left to work out and to verify the veracity of the source information. On the way towards Dasrath Pally I, called two independent witnesses namely 1] Chandan basfore s/o Late Charitra basfore of Dasrath Pally near TB Hospital, Ward No. 44, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Japaiguri 2] Alok Mishra s/o Sharan Mishra of Gandhinagar, Near Roshni Building, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, and informed them about the information in hand and requested them to accompany with us as a witness for search and seizure if necessary.

At about 20.10 hrs I along with force arrived at Dasrath Pally and parked the vehicle at considerable distance and started moving towards TB Hospital and contacted the source over phone. As identified and shown by my source the police team cordoned the said person from all sides and tried to apprehend both of them. But seeing the police team they left the Scooty and tried to fled away from the spot. On the hot chase between the police team and the said persons we managed to apprehend one person and detained him after maintaining his decency. But

another person managed to escape from the spot. I disclosed my identity as Police Officer to him and also my accompanying team as Police persons. On being asked his name and address, he disclosed his name and identity as Rana Majumdar (29) s/o late Anil Majumdar of Ashik Ghat road, Bidhyachakra Colony, Ward No. 44, PS. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri. On enquiry he admitted that he and his friend Bikash Mallik procured huge quantity of Injections from the adjacent areas of Siliguri and used to sell the same to their customers for his wrongful gain. His admission arose strong reason to believe that the above noted person illegally possessed the prohibited injections. Then, in presence of two disinterested witnesses opened the Black Coloured Polythene Carry Bag and recovered the above noted contraband injections inside the bag. I demanded him valid papers / documents in respect of the articles but he failed to produce before the Police team. Accordingly, I seized the recovered contraband injections and One Black and Yellow mixed Colour TVS NTOHQ Scooty bearing Registration No. WB 74 BA 4783 (which was used for the illegal activities by the detained person) under proper seizure memo duly signed by the witnesses and acknowledge by the accused Persons by putting their signatures in seizure list. I then packed labelled and drew samples and marked the samples as noted above. The seizure was made between 20:25 hrs to 20:55 hrs and arrested the detained person U/S 41 Cr.P.C after informing him the ground of arrest.

On further interrogation he admitted that he along with his friend namely Bikash Mallik of Dasrath Pally, Near Munshi Premchand, Ward No.44, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri had been involved in this unlawful act since long and used to procure the above noted seized articles fraudulently from the adjacent areas of Siliguri and used to sell the same to his designed customers for their wrongful gain. He also stated that the detained Scooty belongs to Bikash Mallik which was used for illegal activities.

Under the above circumstances, the accused persons has violated the provision of Drugs and Cosmetics act and liable for punishment. Hence a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Rana Majumdar (29) s/o late Anil Majumdar of Ashik Ghat road, Bidhyachakra Colony, Ward No. 44, PS. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri and his associates namely Bikash Mallik of Dasrath Pally, Near Munshi Premchand, Ward No. 44, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalapaiguri to meet the end of justice.
