Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complaint against The Secretary, Narmada Apartment, Opposite Planet Mall, Beside Mufti Showroom, Sevoke Road, 2nd Mile, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, P.S bhaktinagar.


While on a routine inspection of the site having consumer id 412037849, meter no SF058635, having power connection by WBSEDCL in the name of The Secretary, Narmada Apartment, the address being Narmada Apartment, Opposite Planet Mall, Beside Mufti Showroom, Sevoke Road, 2nd Mile, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, P.S bhaktinagar. I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Sri Jotiska Sengupta, Senior Office Executive, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL and other technical staffs found that an unauthorized energy meter(Capital Meters make, Single Phase energy meter, s/I no A176746 last reading- 3203 Kwh) (not a property of WBSEDCL) was being used directly via hooking from the WBSEDCL common bus bar and bypassing the common meter SF058635. The unauthorized meter was being used to power common services of the building. It was found that 5 nos of incandescent lamps of 200 watts were being used, that is 1000watts or 1Kw total load was observed.

We entered the premises at 1615hrs on 14.03.2022 after handing over Notice to Sri Ajay Kumar Rawal, one of the residents of the building and the applicant of the said connection. Then it was observed that the power was being used in an unauthorized manner via direct hooking from the common bus bar and bypassing the common energy meter of WBSEDCL. Thereby committing a crime as per The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India under section 135 (1) (b). Accordingly the connection was disconnected and both the energy meters and service cable were seized and labelled. A copy of both inspection report and Seizure list (1. Secure Meter, 3Phase, (3X240 Volts), (5-30) amps, SI No SF058635, property of WBSEDCL, 2. Capital meters make, single phase energy meter with reading of 3203 Kwh & 3. Service Cable of Black Color, Multi Stranded, Copper wire of 6 meters approx) were handed over to Sri Ajay Kumar Rawal. We exited the premises on 1650hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against The Secretary, Narmada Apartment under Section 135 (1) (b) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
