Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complaint against Smt Sampa Nandi, Narmada Apartment, Opposite Planet Mall, Beside Mufti Showroom, Sevoke Road, 2nd Mile, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, P.S bhaktinagar.


While on a routine inspection of the site having consumer id 400001398, meter no IPB251814, having power connection by WBSEDCL in the name of Smt Sampa Nandi, Narmada Apartment, the address being Narmada Apartment, Opposite Planet Mall, Beside Mufti Showroom, Sevoke Road, 2nd Mile, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, P.S bhaktinagar. I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with Sri Jotiska Sengupta, Senior Office Executive, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL and other technical staffs found that the meter no IPB251814 was being bypassed via a service cable of 2.5 Sq mm Multi stranded, black colored copper wire to power the same apartment. The unauthorized meter was being used to power the same apartment where the existing connection of Smt Sampa Nandi was prevailing. It was found that the contractual load of the connection was 2.15 Kva.

We entered the premises at 1630hrs on 14.03.2022. Then it was observed that the power was being used in an unauthorized manner via direct hooking from the common bus bar and bypassing the energy meter no IPB251814 of WBSEDCL. Thereby committing a crime as per The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India under section 135 (1) (b). Accordingly the connection was disconnected and the energy meter and service cable were seized and labelled. A copy of the Notice, inspection report and Seizure list (1. Bentec Meter, 1Phase, 240 Volts, (5-30) amps, SI No IPB251814, property of WBSEDCL, 2. Service Cable of Yellow Color, Multi Stranded, Copper wire of 2.5Sqmm of 5 meters approx) were pasted over the door of the property as no one accepted them and pictures of the same has been taken and is being attached here with. We exited the premises on 1702hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Smt Sampa Nandi, Narmada Apartment under Section 135 (1) (b) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
