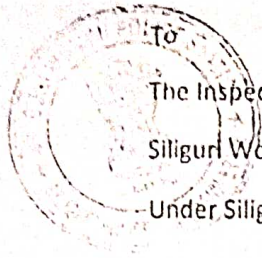

I Smt Rupali Basak Wife of Sri Samir Kumar Basak, Daughter of Sri Srish Chandra Basak, resident of 54 P.C Sarkar Sarani, Hakimpara, P.O & P.S-Siliguri, District-Darjeeling and presently residing at the care and custody of my elder daughter Smt Sanghita Basak, Atul Prasad Sarani, Hakimpara, P.O & P.S-Siliguri, District-Darjeeling do hereby inform you that I was married to Sri Samir Kumar Basak on 03rd January 1975 as per Hindu rituals and customs in presence of my relatives, after 2-3 years of marriage I was subjected to severe mental and physical torture in the hands of my husband, my husband was very proud as he was serving the West Bengal Police and from the very beginning he was sure that no one could do anything to him as he was a police, he used to insult me in front of others in presence of family members and as I was unemployed I was constantly humiliated on every social occasions, moreover he used to insult me based on my educational qualifications.

I thought with passage of time his aggressiveness would decrease rather it increased with passage of time, on 06.10.1975 I gave birth to my eldest daughter namely Smt Sanghita Basak, On 31.03.1982 I gave birth to my younger daughter namely Smt Swarupa Basak and my youngest child is Sri Swarup Basak, after birth of every child I would think that situation would be normal but rather he became more violent, he even used to abuse me in front of all my three children.

He was always a womanizer and used to keep concubines, when I used to demand for the daily needs (cloth, food, medicines) he used to kick and punch me later my children used to provide me the necessities, even after his retirement he earns an amount of Rs 70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand) only from his pension and house rent, he never gave me a single penny for daily expenses, he did not allow our children to come to our residence during the lockdown tenure as a result of which he used to physically torture me regularly, he never used to pay for my doctors visit even those necessities were fulfilled by my children.

On 17th April, 2020 I left my matrimonial house and went to my elder daughters house at Atul Prasad Sarani, Hakimpara as my husband used to keep arms (bhojali, gupti, sword) in the house and used to keep knife under the pillow, I became frightened and thought I will never return back to my matrimonial house, later on 02nd December 2020 by the intervention of well-wishers I returned to
