I, **NANDITA GOPE**, W/O - Partha Pratim Roy, D/O Aviram Gope, Presently residing at Panchkolguri, Vill- Panchkolguri, GP--Fulbari I, Block- Rajganj, P.O. Sahudangir hat, P.S. N.J.P., Dist. Jalpaiguri, Pin No. 735735, do hereby want to inform you that :-

1. That I lodge this F.I.R to the effect that on **22.01.2021** , I was married to Sri Partha Pratim Roy, S/O - Biplob Kumar Roy, Permanent resident of Paschim Dhantala, GP- Fulbari I, Block- Rajganj, P.O. Satellite Township,, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, Pin No. 735015, who is an agent of LIC, code No. LIC0200545E under the Special Marriage Act 1954 **before the Marriage Register, at Jalpaiguri**, and thereafter our marriage was solemnized on 21.02.2021 as per the Hindu rites and customs at my parental house in presence of the relatives.
2. That the time of marriage the family members of my husband give us various wrong information about my husband's job, age etc., and the marriage was solemnized under the false assurances.
3. That during the marriage negotiations, my husband and his family members demanded wardrobe, Dressing Table, Bed etc including all the household articles and cash dowry of Rs. 2,00,000/- from my father. Moreover in this regard I would like to inform you that my husband specifically told my father that all the demanded articles along with cash dowry of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Only) must be given to them prior to marriage ceremony and subsequently as per the demand of my husband, my father has given all the above mentioned articles along with cash dowry of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) and gold ornaments worth Rs. 4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Only) to my husband, in presence of the other relatives.
