
Sub:- F.I.R against Guard :

With due respect and humble submission I would like to draw your attention towards the following facts and circumstances :-

- i) I, Lokesh Periwal, aged 30 years currently residing at 453 Bidhan Road, Ward No-11, Dist-Darjeeling, P.S & P.O- Siliguri, am looking after the business of 3GEN EXTRUSIONS factory owned by my wife Mrs.Sonica Periwal and Two others which is located at Baneshwar More, Siliguri Road, Eastern Bypass, near Lions School, Dist-Jalpaiguri, Pin-734001.
- ii) That one Shankar Barman son of Kartik Barman of residing at Dinhata-1 Bhetaguri, Kharija, Baladanga, CoochBehar-736134. was an employee as a security guard (from Juyel Security Service, Eastern Bypass, near Jaleshwari Bridge, Siliguri, Dist-Jalpaiguri-735135) in our plastic factory named as 3GEN EXTRUSIONS located at Baneshwar More, Siliguri Road, Eastern Bypass, near Lions School, Dist-Jalpaiguri, Pin-734001 for a year about from October 2020 to October 2021.
- iii) Now upon further enquiry it has come to my knowledge that above named guard Shankar Barman. He has embezzled a fund of Rs.2,50,000/- (Two Lakh Fifty Thousand) rupees in the month of December 2021 and further it has come to my knowledge that he

- iv) Sir in the month of October he had taken leave for 15 (Fifteen) days he has not come back and also avoid our calls and messages .
 - v) That Now I feel he shall not come back and is misguiding me and our team in the factory. Sir he has committed theft and breach of trust and cheated the company.
 - vi) We have witness to the entire incident's.
 - vii) That since then I have continuously tried to contact him till a week ago but failed to do so, then ultimately I am compelled to lodge this F.I.R.

Under the above fact and circumstances I humbly request you to look into the matter very seriously and do the needful and book the accused person according to the Law.
