Darjeeling has filed a suit for declaration, injunction and consequential relief along with an application U/Or. 39 rule 1 & 2 of C.P.C. praying for temporary injunction against you in the Court of Ld. Civil Judge Junior Division at Siliguri being Title Suit No. 38/2019 and said application for temporary injunction was moved on 14/02/2019 and after hearing Ld. Court was pleased to pass an order as follows:-

..... " that the application under Order 39 rule 1 & 2 read with Section 151 of C.P.C. is considered and allowed.


The defendants/O.Ps. are hereby restrained from entering into the suit land and from disturbing the peaceful possession of the plaintiff till 14/03/2019."
