Subject: F.I.R regarding Damage of the Property of WBSEDCL

Respected Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son Of Ashoke Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India, would like to lodge a complaint regarding damage of electrical equipments, property of WBSEDCL. At Around 9:30 PM on 11.04.2022 night Power House Customer Care center received information regarding damage of electric equipments and accessories in Amtala Area, Infront of Amtala Youth Club (Kali Mandir), Chayan Para, 2nd Mile Sevoke Road, Dist Jalpaiguri, P.S Bhaktinagar Siliguri. On reaching the site, it was found that a Vehicle, had severely damaged one 11/0.440KV, 160 Kva Distribution Transformer along with the 11Kv XLPE incoming cable, with oil leaking from the DTR body. Prima facie it was reported by the local people that the vehicle was initially parked in front of the Transformer, and had come for repairs to an adjacent garage belonging to the property of Sri Anil (ph no- 9832679581) having electric connection by the name of Sri Khola Khatu Roy. Thus when the vehicle tried to move, it hit the DTR structure causing an explosion sound and damage to the Transformer and other electrical accessories and oil started leaking from the Dtr Body. The total damages caused by the vehicle are approximately around Rs 271202/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Seventy One Thousand Two hundred And Two Only).

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against vehicle under Section 139 of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
