Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 do here by lodge this complain against Sri. Anil Rejwani (Ph no:- 8145369926, S/O Not Known, Occupant of Flat no DA-1, Prestige Enclave, Police Line, Shastri Nagar, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist:- Jalpaiguri. While on a routine Inspection on 19.04.2022. I, Suman Sengupta, Divisional Engineer & Station Manager, Power House CCC along with 1) Sanjay Prasad, Sr O.E, Power House CCC, 2) Sri Malay Goswami, D(E), S & LP, Darjeeling Regional Office, WBSEDCL, and others supporting Officer & staffs visited the premises of Sri. Anil Rejwani, S/O not known. The site being Flat no DA-1, Prestige Enclave, Police Line, Shastri Nagar, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist:- Jalpaiguri.

We entered the premises on 19.04.2022 at 13.00 Hrs after handing over the notice to Smt Mehek Rijwani W/O Anil Rijwani. On Physical inspection at the premises, we detected energy theft via direct hooking from the main Bus Bar of the building using a single phase energy meter of Indo Tech make, with a present reading of 13912 Kwh, the meter was locally purchased and was not the property of WBSEDCL, the meter was being used to enjoy power in an unauthorized manner by directly hooking from the main busbar .

Thus the accused was enjoying the Un authorized Electricity via direct hooking in the premises for domestic purpose. Thereby committing a crime as per The Indian Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 under section 135 (1) (a). It was also found that a total unauthorized load of 2 KW was being enjoyed by the accused. After detection of Energy Theft the Connection was disconnected and the cable used for hooking was Seized & labelled. A Copy of each inspection list, Seizure list (1. Sub Meter of Indo Tech Make, Single Phase, With SI No. 140031 & 2. PVC Wire of 3 meters approx, red in colour, multi stranded) was served to Smt Mehek Rijwani . We exited the Premises at 14.10 hrs.

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation against Sri Anil Rejwani under Section 135 (1) (a) of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
