Saraswati Devi, Wife of Rajbanshi Prasad, Sri Sachin Kumar Gupta, Son of Sri Satya Prakash Gupta, resident of Mahabirsthan, Siliguri are the joint owner of all that piece or parcel of land measuring 1.0612 Acres, recorded in R.S. Khatian No. 2763, corresponding to L.R. Khatian No. 25, 26 & 27, in R.S. Plot No. 74, corresponding to L.R. Plot No. 236, In Sheet No. 18, situated within Mouza Binnaguri, J.L. No. 3, Police Station New Jalpaiguri, District Jalpaiguri, by virtue of our purchase as well as inheritance and I alongwith the said persons have been possessing and enjoying the said land having permanent, heritable and transferable right, title and interest therein, free from all encumbrances and charges whatsoever.

Since the year of 2016, one Ajimul Haque @ Ajimul Rahaman, along with his associates and land grabbers started disturbance in the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said land and I along with the said Saraswati Devi and one Sachin Kumar Gupta was compelled to file a suit against the person, being Title Suit No. 123 of 2016, before the Ld.
