This is to inform you, that myself

'Gupta' who is Samant Agarwal resident of A3 Siddhi Vastha  
would like to register a complaint against my husband  
'In Samant Agarwal', mother in-law 'Mrs Sita Agarwal'  
Father in-law 'In Sajjan Agarwal' for physically assaulting  
me today morning, as I was accused for stealing 60  
thousand rupees from my own locker, which is kept in  
my wardrobe. I was physically assaulted by my  
husband, there was an attempt to murder, he and my  
mother in law tried to forcefully strangle me and  
pushed me outside the house, to which I reacted  
and defended myself. My son and house maid were  
locked inside the house, my mother in law pushed  
me outside saying that the house belongs to her  
and that she can throw me out anytime. She proudly  
said being a senior citizen she can do anything  
with me and for that she has put a court case -  
My family members were immediately threatened on  
phone calls and were told to call me back to  
firozabad, or they would kill me.

In the past also there have  
been incidences, where I was physically assaulted  
an attempt was made to murder me. They have

always demanded cash of Rs 1 Crore and new flat in Siliguri, as earlier my flat A3 was on rent and my father-in-law refused to give it to his own son, as he wanted an independent stay.

On denying such illegal demands, I was always threatened and told that he would take divorce from me. On 1st of May when my mother asked my

mother-in-law for my jewelry which was given to me by my mother during wedding, my 'Street Dhan'

which is kept with her, she denied to give it back to me and played an emotional drama,

saying that I have assaulted her and filed a police complaint for the same.

I have been mentally tormented throughout my pregnancy as my husband and mother-in-law demanded a

male baby, I was thrown out of the house and lived in 'Manvi Appartment' Kholpara from Dec 2020 till April 2021, I was left alone locked up in

the flat for 3 days and was not given food, my

was constantly threatened for asking my mother for a new flat or they would leave me and send me

back to graveyard in my fourth month. My mother

In-law even forced me to undergo abortion, I was

physically assaulted by my husband in my fifth month, due to which I had to bear the consequences

I landed in pre-term labour and was (Part-2)

admitted in angineketan hospital. In my 8<sup>th</sup> month of pregnancy, there was an attempt of murder when I refused to go back to the house because of Covid pandemic. I was threatened by my younger brother-in-law 'Ma Shobbit Agarwal' to leave the house, as the house is registered in his name (A2 flat). After delivery baby, my mother paid him 1 lakh <sup>cash</sup> and four gold chains in August. On 4<sup>th</sup> december 2021, when I had gone to visit my mother with my 6 month old baby, again a police complain was made in my absence that I have fought and left the house, they threatened me not to enter the house and come back to Siliguri, ~~for~~ fake police calls were made and they demanded cash of Rs 1 Crore for the new hospital project, and asked to transfer Honda City car in my husband's name.

I decided to come to Siliguri on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022 with my eight month old infant, I was refused the house keys and was abused by my husband and mother-in-law, they threatened me to kick me out of the house for continuous 2 months. I was bearing all this torments for my son's sake and my family's happiness, as I didn't

intend to keep my son away from his father and  
grandparents and tolerated everything, as I am  
independent of earning myself. I have always  
loved my husband and family and never failed  
as my duties as a wife for him, but today  
with heavy heart, I would like to break this  
silence after 5 years of my marriage, as I was  
physically assaulted in front of my 11 month old  
son. I would join my hands in front of our  
West Bengal Police to give me the justice which  
every respectable Indian woman needs and please  
kindly look into the matter as soon as possible
