I, Sri Dipak Basak, son of Late Fanindra Nath Basak, resident of Surya Sen Coony, Dhupguri, P.O. & P.S. Dhupguri, District - Jalpaiguri, Pin Code: 735210, beg to state you that I have purchased the land from one Smt Anima Roy, D/o Late Tarapada Roy for the land measuring 8 Kathas, situates in R.S. Plot No. 151, sheet No. 11, Mouza - Dabgram and the said land was recorded in the L.R. Khatian No. 225, L.R. Sheet No. 77, Mouza - Dabgram, L.R. Plot no. 125, since the purchase of the aforesaid land, I have been holding, occupying, possessing and enjoying the same having heritable and transferable right, title, interest therein. The said Smt Anima Roy purchased the aforesaid land measuring 8 Kathas 12 Chhataks from one Sri Bimal Chatterjee, by virtue of a Registered Deed of Sale being No. 1934 for the year 1995. The said Bimal Chatterjee purchased the land measuring 12 Kathas 8 Chhataks from one Nuti Singh Roy and Sukhlal Roy both sons of Late Andharu Singh, by virtue of a Registered Sale Deed being no. 2573 for the year 1990. The said Nuti Singh Roy and Sukhlal Roy purchased land measuring 1.33 Acre from their father namely Andharu Singh Roy, S/O Late Mohar Singh Roy in R.S. Plot No. 151 by virtue of a Registered Sale Deed being no. 4850 for the year 1973 with specific boundary as stated in the said deed.

One **Anil Roy**, S/o Sri Talen Roy, resident of Bholanath Para, P.O. Ghogomali, and another **Prasanta Roy**, S/o Sri Ghena Roy, resident Amtala, Notun Bazar, Chayan Para, Ward No. 37 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, both under Ashigarh Out Post, under Bhaktinagar Police Station are notorious land brokers and they have no right, title and interest over my land and in spite of that they have been trying to dispose me from my peaceful possession of land and they have taken many chances to evict me from my possession of land with the help of anti social having nexus with the local land brokers. You are therefore requested to take appropriate legal action against the two aforesaid land brokers namely Anil Roy and Prasanta Roy and oblige me.
