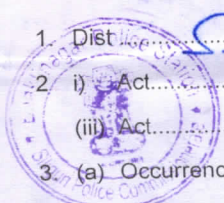

I, Arnab Sengupta, Son of Late Mrinal Sengupta, resident of Military Road, Shantipur, Shivmandir, Post Office -New Rangia via N.B.U., under Police Station -Matigara, District -Darjeeling, would like to inform you that in the afternoon of 06/05/2022, my wife namely Madhushewata Sengupta informed me that she is in Vega Circle Mall at Sevoke Raod with my son namely Arnesh Sengupta (aged about 4 ½ years). After few hours in the evening, when they did not return home, I called my wife in her mobile phone several times but all the time the mobile phone rang but nobody responded. When till late night they did not return home, I started searching for them and searched every possible place but in vain. Even on 07/05/2022, repeated calls were made to my wife's mobile phone but all went unanswered. Her mobile phone is switched off since today morning. I am apprehending kidnapping for some ulterior purpose. Therefore, kindly do the needful to set the law in motion, for which I shall ever pray.
