Sub: Ferocious Robbery at our Home

Dear Sir,

I, Chandan Roy, son of Late
Sailesh Chandra Roy, aged 71, residing at
Anchal Bazar, opposite Sidheswari Kali
Mandir, Siliguri would like to draw
your kind attention to the ferocious
act of robbery happened last night,
on 10/05/2022, around 2.30 am. at
my own house.

Last night around 2.30 am when
me and my wife, Shibani Roy, aged
61 were sleeping at the ~~first~~ first
floor of our house, three masked-men
broke into my house through a small
window at the ground floor. They broke
the door and attacked me with a
rod on my head and attempted to
murder me. I was severely injured
and felt senseless. They also tied me
and threatened my wife. Then they
broke the almirah of the first
room and looted the money and gold
jewellery. They also broke other almirahs
of the house but did not loot
anything from them. Their total activity

time was 40 minutes. Although they covered their faces, my wife could noticed their faces as she put on the lights soon. Hope fully she will identify them when they will be produced. As per her statement, One of them was short-heighted, another was middle-heighted and the last one was tall. Details of missing items are given below.

We will be highly obliged if we will get our missing items back and the culprits will be punished.
