Respected Sir/Madam,

I, **SMT. GARIMA (SITANI) SANGHAI**, Wife of Sri Rohit Sitani and Daughter of Ramesh Kumar Sanghai, presently residing at Jamuna Lal Bajaj Road, Khalpara, Siliguri-734005, P.O. & P.S. Siliguri, District – Darjeeling would like to inform and request you as follows:

1. That I am married to Sri Rohit Sitani, Son of Sri Rajendra Prasad Sitani and our marriage was solemnized on 28.11.2017 at Holiday Inn, Chennai and the same was also registered on 08.12.2017.
2. That after our marriage, I started to reside at my matrimonial house which is situated at 63/25 Rajshekar Road, Sriji Apts, 4th Floor, Mylapore, Chennai-600004 with my husband, father-in-law (Sri Rajendra Prasad Sitani), mother-in-law (Smt. Ambika Sitani) and sister-in-law (Rohini Sitani) and (Rolly Sitani).
3. That soon after the marriage ceremony were over, my mother-in-law started to show her dissatisfaction regarding the gift, jewellery and other items given by my parents. However when I communicated the same to my husband, he assured to look into the matter but never took any step.
4. That around 10 days later, my husband and I shifted to Singapore as my husband was working there but still my mother-in-law kept her behavior intact and often used to scold and taunt me for not doing the household work properly.
5. That after 2 months of my marriage, my in-laws came to Singapore and I thought that it would be a best time to form a bond with them however all my aspiration went into vain. My in-laws used to taunt me about my standard of living and often used to state that I never deserved such a good family.
6. That I was forced to work day and night and none of my in-laws helped me in any way. Slowly my health deteriorated and I fell sick, but my in-laws still continued to torture me. With each passing day I understood that I was unwanted in the family but still I tried my best to be a part of the family.
7. That in the month of March 2018, I came back to Siliguri at my parental home for Gangaur Puja and when I expressed by desire to stay a bit long as it wouldn't be possible to come again from Singapore, my in-laws started taunting me and pressurized me to come to Chennai. They often used to ask me to bring money as well as my basic

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necessities from my parents and on denial used to taunt and criticize me. That during my stay in Chennai I received only insult and mental torture from my in-laws.

8. That my in-laws always tried to create gap between me and my husband. In the month of April 2018, my husband, my in-laws and me planned a vacation to U.S. and during this tenure all I received was insult from my in-laws and often I was looked down upon by my husband .
9. That in the month of November 2018, I along with my husband came to Chennai for Diwali and on reaching home, I was immediately assigned the work of cleaning, cutting vegetables, washing utensils and cooking. The servants were given off and I was compelled to do all the household works without any support from anybody and even after finishing all works my in-laws kept me busy in some or the other useless work without giving me any time to take rest and due to this reason I became very weak from inside and started staying unhealthy but unfortunately despite of these I was always subjected to mental torture taunted and harassed. I was being treated like a maid and when I tried to talk about all these to my husband, my in-laws tortured me both physically and mentally.
10. That with time my husband started to ignore me and my family member. In the month of January 2019 when my grandfather became ill and was on death bed. I expressed my willingness to visit my parental home and meet him and to which my father-in-law replied that "your grandfather is very old and ill and no one can stop him from dying so let him die" my grandfather left the world and I did not get a chance to see him.
11. That to distract my- self I took a job in a Tele Sale Company but this did not go down with my in-laws and they kept abusing me and even threatened of dire consequences. I was subjected to a lot more house chores and wasn't allowed to devote time in my work and finally I had quit my job.
12. That suddenly on 27th of April 2020 my husband became violent and smashed my face on the bed back and pulled my hair. I was taken aback by this behavior and it felt that my whole world has shattered. I gave my heart and soul to make this marriage work but all I received was insult, harassment and pain.
13. That thereafter things started getting sour and time and again my husband used to get physically violent but I had no option but to stay in the same house and endure everything as the whole world was under lockdown. I could not even expressed my pain to my parents as I did not want to trouble them during this testing time.
14. That I still tried to figure out ways to reconcile and make my marriage work but internally I had lost all hope in my marriage and have also lost all my confidence and went to mental distress and trauma.

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15. In the month of November, 2021 I along with my husband came to Siliguri for my Brothers marriage and as soon as we reached the venue my husband started to speak ill about my parents and the arrangements made and when I tried to request him to adjust my husband hit me intensively. He pushed me hard and I fell on the ground. I became numb and could not understand anything but to maintain my family's dignity I had to keep my mouth shut.
16. That when the wedding ceremony was over I informed my parents about the inhuman treatment faced by me and my father approached my in-laws and explained them the whole scenario and asked them to come to Siliguri so that the matter could be mend and a solution to all the problem could be found.
17. That my husband left Siliguri with an assurance that he will come back with my in-laws however no such thing happened and after that day neither did my in-laws nor my husband ever contacted me.
It is worthy to mention here that all my original Documents and ID Cards used to be under the custody of either my father-in-law or my husband and till date all the documents are with my father-in law and without them I am facing huge troubles and harassment.
18. That after all this incidents I faced a lot of mental distress and emotional breakdown. I often felt suicidal and had to resort to professional help. The tremendous amount of physical, mental, psychological torture caused upon me has shattered me completely.
19. That on several occasions my father tried to contact my father-in-law by he kept on ignoring the same and blocked my father and conveyed message from his relative that my husband no more wants to continue the marriage and hence want to get separated.
20. That I am in the state of true perfidy and have been residing with my parents since past 6 months with merely no source of income. In the 4 years of this marriage, I have only faced humiliation, insult, torture, distress when I had only demanded nothing but self-respect, support and love which I was completely deprived off and now I am in the state of helplessness and all my endurance have failed.

Therefore you are humbly requested to look after the matter and take strict action against my husband and in-laws.
