Sub: Rehabilitation and upgrading to 2/4 lane with paved shoulders and strengthening of Nepal Border (from Kakarbita – Panitanki - Bagdogra- Shivmandir - Medical More – Naukaghat- Fulbari- Bangla Bandha) to Bangladesh Border, Total Length – 37.27 km, AH-02, in the state of West Bengal - Cut & Theft of Road Safety Retro reflective Signages with MS Posts & Frame and Metal Beam Crash Barrier (MBCB) from Lalpha Bridge to Singhijhora Tea Estate, Upper Bagdogra of AH-02 section- reg.

Sir,

With reference to above mentioned Memo and discussion held with our representative at your good office yesterday evening about the captioned subject . It is once again reiterate that, during inspection by Highway Patrolling Team of AH-02 on 08.05.2022, 11.05.2022 & even today morning, it was observed & reported that total 24 Nos. of Retro Reflective Signages with MS Posts have been cut down from bottom of Circular Pipe & Angular Sections Posts (with Black & White coloured) of Signages installed as per IRC: 67-2012 in between Lalpha Bridge (Km. 13+870 of AH-02/ Km. 17+378 of NH-327) and Upper Bagdogra (Singhijhora Tea Estate, Km. 16+860 of AH-02/ Km. 14+338 of NH-327) by miscreants during intervention of night & dawn time. Also, miscreants have stolen 23 Nos. C-Section Spacer Bar & 12 Meter Double W-Beam of Metal Beam Crash Barrier (MBCB) today from the Approach of Km. 16+200 (Jabrali, under Bagdogra P.S.) Minor Bridge from Both Hand sides.

Location & type of Road Safety Retroreflective Signages & Posts lists of Cut & Stolen are enclosed herewith for your needful action please. Most of the stolen Signages were Mandatory/Regulatory Signs, Cautionary/Warning Signs and Informatory/Guide Signs for road users; even all advanced & immediate “Elephant Crossing” Retroreflective Signages of RHS side (under Bagdogra P.S.), which were most important at AH-02 stretch to alert road users about Elephant Crossing zone, has been cut & stolen from its positions. It is to reiterate that, with reference to ADCP (Traffic) under SPC office Memo No. 2258/ADCP/TRF/SPC/21, dated 30.07.2021, it was instructed for fixing of additional “Accident Prone Zone, Go Slow” Retroreflective Signages at 6 different locations, same was installed at an earlier date at Kestopur location at Both sides along with other locations. Out of two signages of “Accident Prone Zone, Go Slow”, one signage at Km. 14+680 RHS (Kestopur, under Bagdogra P.S.) have been cut & stolen from bottom of Posts by culprits. On 11.05.2022, Culprits had left out Retroreflective Signage (Elephant Crossing, Speed Limit, No Parking, Stop) with MS Frame as unworthy condition at Km. 13+560 RHS (Kiran Chandra Tea Estate near Kestopur), adjacent to Drain, under jurisdiction of Bagdogra P.S.

We are enclosing Geotagging photographs as evidence & details of cut & stolen Retro reflective signages with posts & MBCBs appended below for your reference & needful action please :
