Sir, we were staying in Montana Vista
Room No 204 on 13th May 2022 due to my
daughter Reception.

We checked in room around 12:30 pm.
After that we went for lunch down with my
wife, son and daughter in law.

Before leaving the room, I took a towel
from my suit case and checked all ornaments were
present in the suit case.

In evening while getting ready, my wife
found all the ornaments of her and daughter in law
missing.

My son went to reception to complain and
see CCTV footage around 6 pm where initially it
was told by staff that CCTV can only be shown
in morning at 9 am next day when OTS
staff comes.

At 9 pm after repeated request, CCTV
camera was shown.

In video footage it was seen that
one person entered the room around 1:33:10 pm in
our room while we were having lunch down. 2nd time
same person with another hotel staff entered around
1:45:25 pm. 3rd time one hotel lady entered the
room just after few minutes after two left.
fourth time same lady entered the room around

1:50:20 pm. We finally came up around 2 pm
after having lunch.

I request you to kindly look into
this matter when management and staff of
Hotel Montana Vista is involved and investigate the
case.

Kindly consider this letter as my official complaint letter
and do the needful at the earliest. I am
providing my and my daughter in law contact
details for any further clarification.
