In producing herewith one accused person namely Bapi Roy (26yrs) Male S/o. Lt. Mantu Roy of Vill-Farabari, Nepali Busty, PO. PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. 14(Fourteen) Bottles Himalayan Gold Pet. 60 up County spirit Containing 600 ML.

I, SI. Rakesh Debnath of Ambari Falakata out post under NJP PS/SPC lodged a written complainant against the above noted person to the effect that today i.e. on 21.05.2022 at 17:45hrs while myself along with force left for Evening raid Duty Vide Ambari-Falakata OP GDE No. 763 Dated: 21.05.2022 in course of raid duty I received an information from my source that one Bapi Roy (26yrs) Male S/o. Lt. Mantu Roy of Vill-Farabari, Nepali Busty, PO. PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri which is huge amount of liquor illegally for selling the same in the customer for his wrongful gain. Accordingly I informed to O/C Ambari Falakata out post about the information. As per his kind instruction I along with, ASI. Biswajit Ghosh, 2. C/876 Ram Chandra Oraon, 3.C/824 Satyaban Roy, 4. VP-014 Paritosh Roy all of Ambari - Falakata OP, Under NJP - PS, SPC proceed to Farabari to work out the information. At 18:05 hrs we reached at the spot, sometimes after being identified by the source our police party held raid at the Shop/House of one Bapi Roy (26yrs) Male S/o. Lt. Mantu Roy of Vill-Farabari, Nepali Busty, PO. PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and recovered the above noted articles from the possession of above noted accused person namely one Bapi Roy (26yrs). On demand he could not produce any valid license/documents in support of said liquor. He become a nervous and admitted his guilt before us and stated that he sell the same in the customer since long for his wrongful gain. In presence of witnesses namely 1. Bakul Barua S/o. Sri. Chinta Mohan Barua of Baruapara, PO. Talma, PS. Kotwali, Dist-Jalpaiguri and 2) Pranab Chowdhury S/o. Lt. Surath Kr. Chowdhury of 09 No. Colony, Ambari, PO. Kamarvita, PS. NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri. Accordingly I seized the above noted articles from the possession of above noted accused person after preparing proper seizure list and took signature of the accused person and witnesses. The seizure was made between 18.15 hrs to 18:30hrs. And I arrested the said person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. and issued Memo of arrest appraising the ground of arrest in presence of witnesses.

I therefore request you a specific case may kindly be started against the accused person namely Bapi Roy (26yrs) Male S/o. Lt. Mantu Roy of Vill-Farabari, Nepali Busty, PO. PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
