I, A.S.I. Inzamamul Hoque of Ashighar OP Under Bhaktinagar P.S, SPC do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that today i.e. 22.05.2022 I along with C/1013 Sanjay Singha and CV/909 Nityananda Choudhry performing morning mobile van duty at Ashighar OP area vide Ashighar OP GDE no. 504 Dated 22.05.2022 & MCC no.670/2022 dated 22.05.2022 at 10.45 hrs. received a information that some local Public of Fakdaibari & Panchanan Road area blocked Estern Bypass Road in front of Dhakeshwari Mandir. Wasting no time myself along with available force left for Estern Bypass Road in front of Dhakeshwari Mandir to work out the veracity of the information. On arrival at the spot at 10.50 hrs. I found that under the leadership of (1) Dipankar Das of Netajipara Rawatbari, Panchanan Road PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (2) Bocha of Netajipara Panchanan Road PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (3)Sribash of Near Dhakeshwari Mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (4) Biplab Tikadar of Hatiadanga PS Bhaktinagar dist. Jalpaiguri (5) Priya Das of Bihind Dhakeshwari Mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri, (6) Tapan Sarkar of Fakdaibari Near Dhakeshwari mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. jalpaiguri approx 75 local public of Fakdaibari & Panchanan road area including 20 female blocked Estern Bypass Road in front of Dhakeshwari Mandir, making the road impassable over the issue to remove the road divider immediately from Estern Bypass road in front of Dhakeshwari Mandir. All the vehicular traffic were jeopardized. They also restrained the movement of Govt. vehicles. I told the agitators to withdraw the road blocked programme but they did not pay any heed. Photograph of the road blocked programme was taken. The road blocked programme was started at 10:35 hrs. of 22.05.2022 and at 11:15 hrs. of 22.05.2022 the road blocked programme was withdrawn. Time to time informative actions has been taken.

On the above circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against the accused persons namely (1) Dipankar Das of Netajipara Rawatbari, Panchanan Road PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (2) Bocha of Netajipara Panchanan Road PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (3)Sribash of Near Dhakeshwari Mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri (4) Biplab Tikadar of Hatiadanga PS Bhaktinagar dist. Jalpaiguri (5) Priya Das of Bihind Dhakeshwari Mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. Jalpaiguri, (6) Tapan Sarkar of Fakdaibari Near Dhakeshwari mandir PS Bhaktinagar Dist. jalpaiguri and approx 75 others unidentified local public of Fakdaibari and Panchanan road area and arrange for its investigation.
