In producing herewith 02 (Two) arrested accused persons named (1) Subrata Sarkar (40 Yrs) S/o Tapan Sarkar Of Fakdoibari, P.o-Ghogomali, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri and (2) Papai Roy@Pappu (33 yrs) S/o Lt. Satya Roy Of South Shantinagar, Benoy More, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaigri along with seized articles (i) One iron-made 'Khukri'(Sharp cutting) recovered from the possession of Subrata Sarkar (40Yrs) S/o Tapan Sarkar Of Fakdoibari, P.o-Ghogomali, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri which was kept concealed on the back side of his waist (ii) one Sword (sharp cutting weapon) recovered from the Possession of Papai Roy@Pappu (33 yrs) S/o Lt. Satya Roy Of South Shantinagar, Benoy More, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaigri (iii) One iron rod measuring approx 25" pointed one end recovered from the Place of occurrence during search (iv) one three Cell torch light under proper seizure list.

I, SI Rakesh Debnath of Ambari-Falakata OP, PS-NJP/SPC, do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 02.06.2022 in course of mobile van patrolling duty received secret source information that 10-12 persons had assembled in the bank of Sahu River behind Balaram Power Grid to commit dacoity at the locality. Immediately informed the tip of information to O/C, Ambari-Falakata OP and as per his kind direction myself, C/625 Bhabendra Das & NVF/029 Kiran Roy along with Special night van Officer ASI Uday Shankar Bhattacharya , CV/340, Sushen Roy & Cv/483 Khirmohan Roy left for Balaram to verify the veracity of information. This refers to Amb_Fkt OP GDE No. 37 dt.02.06.2022. At about 00.15 hrs I along with the police party arrived near Balaram Power Grid and after keeping our vehicle there we proceeded towards Sahu River-banks on foot and being indicated by the source found from the considerable distance that a gang of 10-12 persons were assembled behind the bushes at the bank of Sahu River and they were whispering in very low voice. Accordingly, we cordoned the place properly and approach towards them. But seeing the presence of police party, they scattered in multi direction and started fleeing away but after a hot chase manage to apprehend two persons and other persons fled away from the spot. On interrogation, the apprehended persons disclosed their name and address as noted above and started giving incoherent statement regarding their presence/gathering in the same place also. On further grilling they stated that they along with (1) Naba Chakraborty (2) Bapi Roy, (3) Joymohan, (4) Ramaoni, (5)Dharmanath, (6) Parimal, (7) Supen, (8) Arun Sharma & others assembled there in preparation to commit dacoity. Accordingly, I managed to call two independent witnesses (i) Kanailal Biswas S/o Lt. Gurudas Biswas Of Kamarvita, Amabri, P.o-Kamarvita, Ps-NJP, Dist-Jalpaiguri & (ii) Bokul Barua S/o Chintamohan Barua Of

Under the above fact and circumstances, I pray that a specific case may kindly be started against (1) Subrata Sarkar (40 Yrs) S/o Tapan Sarkar Of Fakdoibari, P.o-Ghogomali, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri, (2) Papai Roy@Pappu (33 yrs) S/o Lt. Satya Roy Of South Shantinagar, Benoy More, Ps-Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri and (3) Naba Chakraborty (4) Bapi Roy, (5) Joymohan, (6) Ramaoni, (7)Dharmanath, (8) Parimal, (9) Supen, (10) Arun Sharma & others under proper Section of law.
