Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accused person named Amal Haldar @ Suku (68 yrs), S/O Lt. Binod Haldar of Kawakhali, Bidhan Pally P.O-Sushruta Nagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling along with copy of memo of arrest, seizure list and seized articles viz 17 (Seventeen) Sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of Rs. 2040/- marked as exhibit "A" and one bottle taken as sample.

The fact of the case is that today on 05.06.2022 at 18:25 hrs received source information that one Amal Haldar @ Suku, S/O Lt. Binod Haldar of Kawakhali, Bidhan Pally P.O-Sushruta Nagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling have stored huge quantity of I.D liquor at his Petty shop near Desun hospital illegally for sale to the People for his wrongful gain.

I informed the matter to O/C NBMC OP and as per his direction I along with force, C/883 Krishna Ranjan Singha, C.V-158 Partha Sarkar left for Kawakhali to work out the information. At about 18:45 hrs held raid at the petty shop of Amal Haldar @ Suku, S/O Lt. Binod Haldar of Kawakhali, Bidhan Pally P.O-Sushruta Nagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling and on search 17 (Seventeen) Sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of @ Rs. 2040/- have been recovered. On demand he could not produce any documents / License for his possession such quantity of I.D liquor. On interrogation he confessed that he stored the said I.D liquor illegally for sale to the interested persons for his wrongful gain.

So, I seized the said 17 (Seventeen) Sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of @ Rs. 2040/in presence of witnesses under proper seizure memo and arrested him U/S 41 Cr.P.C.

Under the above circumstances I pray before your kind self that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be initiated against the accused person named Amal Haldar @ Suku, S/O Lt. Binod Haldar of Kawakhali, Bidhan Pally P.O-Sushruta Nagar, P.S- Matigara, Dist-Darjeeling and kindly arranged for its investigation.


