ILLEGAL CONSTRUCTION NEAR DEF LAND

1. On routine reconnaissance of Defence land adjoining with Kamalpur Tea estate (Labours lines) from boundary pillar No 156 to 158, it is noticed that some illegal constructions are coming up within 50 to 70 meters of the above boundary pillars of Defence Land, which is complete violation of order of Govt of India, Min of Defence letter No 11026/2/2011/D(Lands) dated 18 May 2011(copy att).

2. The unit reconnaissance team has instructed the individuals concerned to immediately stop and remove the illegal constructions.
3. The undersigned visited the the Kamalpur Tea estate Office on 06 Jun 2022 and interacted with the manager, Mr Devender Roy and apprised him about the illegal construction on their land without the NOC duly obtained from the Local Military Authority (LMA).
4. In view of the above, you are requested to take suitable legal action against the Tea estate and its above mentioned labourers to stop and remove the illegal construction without further delay.
5. In this context kindly **lodge an FIR** immediately.
