In producing herewith two (02) arrested accused person/lady namely 1. Bikash Sha (27) S/O Lt. Ram Bhajan Sha of NJP Netaji More, Janata Para, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri (not verified) and 2. Purnima Biswas (30) W/O Suren Biswas of Bokhravita, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (not verified) along with the following articles under seizure as per seizure list

- i) One packet containing 2.5 Kgs of "Ganja" wrapped with brown colour cello-tape being kept inside a black colour bag stilled as 'New Rahat Bag' - seized from the possession of above noted Bikash Sha and marked as 'Exhibit-A',
- ii) One packet containing 2.4 Kgs of "Ganja" wrapped with brown colour cello-tape being kept inside a plastic bag stilled as 'Astha' - seized from the possession of above noted lady accused namely Purnima Biswas and marked as 'Exhibit-B',

I, SI Newton Biswas, S/O- Nirmal Biswas of New Jalpaiguri Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint against above noted accused person/lady to the effect that on 07.06.2022 at about 14.15 hrs I received a specific source input that two peron/lady were standing near Mahananda Bridge, Porajhar More under New Jalpaiguri Police Station with huge quantity of Ganja for delivering the same to their designed customers. After informing the matter to the Officer-In- Charge, New Jalpaiguri Police Station in written and being directed, I along with ASI Sajal Das, LC/1328 Sangreta Maley, HG/794 Ranjit Roy, VP /08 Laxman Roy, VP/ 13 Jamirul Islam, CV/ 116 Rohit Kumar Mahato and and LCV /838 Nur Nehar Banu all belongs to New Jalpaiguri Police Station left for Mahananda Bridge, Porajhar More under PS- NJP by Govt. vehicle to verify the veracity of the information vide New Jalpaiguri PS GDE No. 334 Dtd. 07.06.2022 and M.C C. NO. 2022 Dt. 07.06.2022.

Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender.

At the time of departure from Police Station I took envelope, white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, Digital weighing machine (Certified by the weight and Metallurgy department) etc.

On way to Mahananda Bridge, Porajhar More under New Jalpaiguri Police Station, I contacted two persons namely (i) Sukamal Sen Gupta S/O Lt. Subir Sen Gupta of Saktigarh, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and (ii) Budhadev Saha S/O Arun Saha of Surya Sen Colony, Block- E, W/No.34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and make them aware of the information in hand and requested them to act as witness, if any search and seizure would be made necessary upon which they agreed. Thereafter we along with the independent witnesses reached near Mahananda Bridge, Porajhar More under New Jalpaiguri Police Station at 14.45 hrs and being pointed by my reliable source approached towards one accused person and one lady accused person standing there, each of them carrying one bag. At that time seeing the Police party approaching towards them, they started fled away from the spot but, however we managed to them with bag under conscious and exclusive possession of above noted Bikash Sha and Purnima Biswas.

Thereafter, we disclosed our identity and the information in hand and stated that they will be searched in person for the purpose. At this, they after disclosing their identity as noted above admitted that they have illegally possessed ganja in their possession for selling the same to their designed customers as per requirement. I then gave them option in writing whether they wanted to be searched in presence of an Executive Magistrate or by any Gazetted Officer. Then they agreed to be searched in presence of any one of the above. I also offered the independent witnesses and the accused persons to search our Police Party as per provisions but, they did not search the police party.
