Sir,

In producing here with the one arrested accused person namely Parbat Thapa (50yrs) S/o- Lt. Chandra Bahadur Thapa of Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18, PS- Siliguri, Darjeeling along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. Twelve (12) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. (Total market value RS/- 120 X 12 = 1440/-)

I PSI Sumit Rawat of Siliguri PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge a written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Parbat Thapa (50yrs) S/o- Lt. Chandra Bahadur Thapa of Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18, PS- Siliguri, Darjeeling to the effect that on 10/06/2022 at about 18.55 hrs during my PC mobile van duty (vide Siliguri PS GDE no-587 dated 10/06/2022) I received a source information from Ranabusty, Subashpally under Siliguri PS that one person namely Parbat Thapa is selling huge quantity of liquor illegally at Ranabusty in his home to his design customers since long, for his wrongful gain. After received the information myself along with, ASI Rabin lama CV/ Prosenjit Dey, CV/ Ramanath Barman proceeded to the P.O to work out the source information, at about 19.05 hrs I along with my police team reached at Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18 and, on being identified by the source our police team held raid in the house of Parbat Thapa and managed to apprehended the said person and recovered Twelve (12) bottles of Himalayan gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml, which is containing in a white coloured plastic Bag. On interrogation he disclosed his identification as Parbat Thapa (50yrs) S/o- Lt. Chandra Bahadur Thapa of Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18, PS- Siliguri, Darjeeling and he admitted that he is selling the same to his design customers from since long for his wrongful gain.

On demand he failed to produce any valid documents or license in r/o said liquor, accordingly I seized the said Twelve (12) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml (Total market value RS/- 120 X 12 = 1440/-) from the possession of Parbat Thapa (50yrs) S/o- Lt. Chandra Bahadur Thapa of Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18, PS- Siliguri, Darjeeling (**seizure and labelled was made between 19.25 hrs to 19.55 hrs**) in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As he violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act, as such I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraise him the ground of arrest and issued arrest memo in presence of witnesses.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour to take legal action against the arrested person namely Parbat Thapa (50yrs) S/o- Lt. Chandra Bahadur Thapa of Ranabusty, Subashpally, W/no- 18, PS- Siliguri, Darjeeling under proper section of law.
