Body of a female subject, average built & nourished. Eye closed, cornea hazy, pupils dilated & fixed B/L. RMS present all over the body. PMS present at back of the body at dependent part except pressure point. Scalp hair 11", black. Blood stain present at different part of the body. Blood stain fluid coming from Lt. ear.

Injuries- (1) Abrasion 3" x 4" Lt. side of the face and chick front of Rt. shoulder. (2) By lateral peri orbital contusion. (3) LWS 3" x 2" at Lt. parietal area O/D, scalp hematoma all over the scalp with multiple fragmentation of the skull bone over an area of 2" x 2" at Lt. temporo parietal area, O/D there is SDH at Lt. cerebral hemisphere extended upto base with multiple hemorrhagic contusions present at both cerebral hemispheres causing pressure effect over brain tissue. The injuries are showing evidences of vital reactions. No other injury except those noted could have been detected even after carefully examination & dissection.
