With due respect and producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely (i) Lalu Yadav (36) s/o Ramadhar Yadav of Barandin, PO- Bhalua, PS-Barachalti, Dist.- Gaya, Bihar (ii) Dipu Kumar s/o Ram Chadar Yadav of Naraha, PS- Mohanpur, Dist.- Gaya, Bihar under arrest and the following articles under seizure :-

- (i) One truck displaying number plate NL/01/AE/1364
- (ii) 1,500 [One Thousand Five Hundred] cartonn of Rooby's MAHARAJA Rare Wiskey containing 12 bottle in each cartoon [Total=1,8000 bottles] containing 750 ml in each bottle marked as Rs-110/- in each bottle i.e Total- 19,80,000/- [Nineteen Lakh Eighty Thousand only]

I PSI-Pradeep Diyali of NJP PS, SPC do hereby lodge this complaint against the above noted arrested accused persons that today (19.06.2022) at about 17.15 hrs I received a source information that one truck displaying number plate NL/01/AE/1364 is coming from Assam Side towards Bihar which is loaded with huge quantity of spurious liquor which was manufacturing illegally. Accordingly, I informed the fact to you and diarised the fact in General diary vide NJP PS GDE No 946 dated 19.06.2022 and as per your kind direction myself along with ASI Sajal Das, VP/08 Laxman Roy, CV/116 Rohit Mahato, CV/306 Biswajit Roy and CV/824 Niru Yadav, VP/13 Jamirul Islam left for Jatiyakali More vide MCC No.- 2105 date: 19.06.2022 to verify the veracity of the information in hand. Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender. In the mean time I called two independent witnesses namely (i) Buddha Dev Saha s/o Arun Saha of Suryasen Colony, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and (ii) Sukamal Sengupta S/O late Subir Sengupta of Shaktigarh Road No-3, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and informed them about the information in hand and requested them to remain present with us as witness during the search and seizure if necessary and in which they agreed. At 1735 hrs we arrived at Jatiyakali More and at 1815 hrs we managed to intercept the said truck bearing number plate NL/01/AE/1364 at Jatikali More under NJP PS and found two persons inside the drivers cabin. On interrogation they disclosed their identity as noted above. Subsequently, we searched the vehicle and found the above noted spurious liquor loaded in the said vehicle. On demand the above noted accused persons failed to produce any valid documents in respect of the above noted spurious liquor loaded in the vehicle as well as any documents in respect the vehicle. Being further interrogated they disclosed that they in connivance with others and after getting the permission of the truck owner they have procured the above noted spurious liquor from Assam by illegal way with a view to sell the same in Bihar for their personal gain.

Accordingly, I seized the above noted truck and the above noted spurious liquor loaded in the vehicle from the conscious possession of the above noted accused persons namely (i) Lalu Yadav (36) s/o Ramadhar Yadav of Barandin, PO- Bhalua, PS-Barachalti, Dist.- Gaya, Bihar (ii) Dipu Kumar (19) s/o Ram Chadar Yadav of Naraha, PS- Mohanpur, Dist.- Gaya, Bihar under proper seizure list and subsequently arrested them u/s 41 Cr.P.C after observing all formalities and informing them ground of their arrest. The whole process of seizure was made in between 1835 hrs to 2145 hrs.
