Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I PSI Newton Biswas of NJP P.S do hereby lodge a written complaint against 1] Biswajit Ganguli, 2] Birju Sahani, 3] Totan Shil, 4] Sunil Biswas, 5] Nantu Goon, 6] Kanu Adhikary, 7] Nirmal Malakar, 8] Amrit Sahani, 9] Md. Azad, 10] Dipak Mandal, 11] Sajal Saha and 20/25 others to the effect that on 24.06.2022 at 07.55 hrs. Myself along with CV/896 Ashok Mondal and CV/300 Madhab Roy all of New Jalpaiguri PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate had been detailed to perform patrolling duty. During my patrolling duty I received information from duty officer that local people near Jorapani bridge started a road blocked in front of Jorapani Bridge over the issue of a bad drainage system in that area. Accordingly after informing the matter to the Officer-In- Charge, New Jalpaiguri Police Station and being directed, I along with forces left for Jorapani Bridge under PS- NJP.

Thereafter, we reached the spot at 11.30 hrs. and found that around 30/35 persons had assembled there under the leadership of above noted persons who had blocked road in front of Jorapani Bridge with an intention to mischief by injury to public roads and were raising slogans for their demands. The road block had stopped the free flow of traffic, causing traffic jams and harassment the public in general. We requested several times to withdraw the road blocked but picketers did not pay any heed. The road blocked was continuing more or less 30 minutes.

Under the above circumstances, I pray to you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the above noted accused namely 1] Biswajit Ganguli, 2] Birju Sahani, 3] Totan Shil, 4] Sunil Biswas, 5] Nantu Goon, 6] Kanu Adhikary, 7] Nirmal Malakar, 8] Amrit Sahani, 9] Md. Azad, 10] Dipak Mandal, 11] Sajal Saha and 20/25 others and arrange for its investigation.
