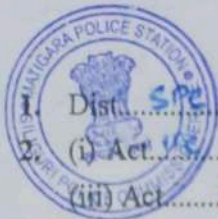


In this regards, I Tuhin Kumar Talukdar, Civil Sector of Sector No -7 of Matigara Block of JEWRRD lodged this written complaint against driver and others of vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB -74 BG 9103 having name plate of MLA Darjeeling. The fact is that today on 25.06.2022 at about 20:25 hrs received a information that two persons boarded in vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB -74 BG 9103 having name plate of MLA Darjeeling are moving at Matigara Block area to intimidate the voters in c/w ensuing Siliguri Mahakuma Parishad Election 2022. Accordingly, I along with others MCC Team lead by Sri. Rabin Sarkar and other officials tried to trace out the vehicle. At about 21:50 hrs we detained the vehicle at Haler Matha under Matigara PS, Dist- Darjeeling. I informed the matter to BDO Matigara and as per his direction I communicated with the Police Team. Accordingly, at about 22:10 hrs Police Team lead by SI Md. Sanaullah of Matigara PS, SPC came to the spot. We searched the vehicle thoroughly in presence of Police, but nothing untoward could be found.


On question the driver and the other passenger disclosed their name and address as (i) Ongden Lepcha (38), S/O Ongdup Lepcha of Ward No-11, A.J.C Bose Road, PO+PS- Sadar, Dist- Darjeeling (ii) Samir Tamang (32), S/O Rajen Tamang of Bharat Busty, PO- New Rangia, PS - Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and also stated that the vehicle is belongs to MLA Darjeeling namely Shri. Niraj Zimba. But they could not give any satisfactory answer for moving at the area with the vehicle of MLA Darjeeling and was intimidating the voters /electors as directed by Shri. Niraj Zimba thus they violated the Model Code of Conduct.

In our presence Police officer seized the vehicle bearing Reg. No. WB -74 BG 9103 having name plate of MLA Darjeeling under proper seizure list and arrested the above noted two persons.

I therefore request you to start a specific case against the both arrested accused (i) Ongden Lepcha (38), S/O Ongdup Lepcha of Ward No-11, A.J.C Bose Road, PO+PS- Sadar, Dist- Darjeeling (ii) Samir Tamang (32), S/O Rajen Tamang of Bharat Busty, PO- New Rangia, PS - Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and others for violation of Model Code of Conduct and for intimidated the voters.
