In producing here with the one arrested accused person namely Sankar Biswas (34) s/o late Sattaranjan Biswas of Sarbahara Colony, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

- 1. Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. (Total market value RS/- 120 X 18 = Rs- 2160)

I ASI Rabin Lama of Siliguri PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge a written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Sankar Biswas (34) s/o Sattaranjan Biswas of Sarbahara Colony, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 27/06/2022 at about 20.15 hrs during my PC mobile van duty (vide Siliguri PS GDE no-1559 dated 27/06/2022) I received a source information from Sarbahara Colony ward no- 28 under Siliguri PS that one person namely Sankar Biswas he selling huge quantity of liquor illegally at Sarbahara colony ward no 28 in his house to his design customers since long, for his wrongful gain. After received the information myself along with, ASI Siben Sarkar, ASI Debasis Das, CV/ Prosenjit Dey, CV/ Ramanath Barman proceeded to the P.O to work out the source information, at about 20.30 hrs I along with my police team reached at Tikiapara Matangini- 01, ward no 28 and, on being identified by the source our police team held raid in the house of Sankar Biswas and managed to apprehended the said person and recovered Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml, which is containing in a white coloured plastic Bag. On interrogation he disclosed his identification as Sankar Biswas (34) s/o Sattaranjan Biswas of Sarbahara Colony, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling and he admitted that he sell the same to his design customers from since long for his wrongful gain. On demand he failed to produce any valid documents or licence in r/o said liquor, accordingly I seized the same viz; 1. Eighteen (18) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml (Total market value RS/- 120 X 18 = RS/- 2160) from the possession of Sankar Biswas (34) s/o Sattaranjan Biswas of Sarbahara Colony, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling (**seizure and labelled was made between 20.45 hrs to 21.25 hrs**) in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As he violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act, as such I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraise him the ground of arrest and issued arrest memo in presence of witnesses.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour to take legal action against the arrested person namely Sankar Biswas (34) s/o Sattaranjan Biswas of Sarbahara Colony, near ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling under proper section of law.
