Sir,

In producing here with the one arrested accused Smt Marzina Khatun (40 yrs) W/o- Md. Bappa of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

Sixteen (16) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. (Total market value RS/- 120 X 16 = Rs 1920/-)

I ASI Rabin Lama of Siliguri PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge a written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Marzina Khatun (40 yrs) W/o- Md. Bappa of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 28/06/2022 during my PC mobile van duty (vide Siliguri PS GDE no-1613 dated 28/06/2022) I received a source information at about 14.45 hrs from Tikiapara, ward no 28 under Siliguri PS that one Smt Marzina Khatun of Tikiapara, Matangini- II is selling huge quantity of liquor illegally in her house to her design customers since long, for her wrongful gain. After received the information myself along with, ASI Siben Sarkar, LC/1282 Swastika Sharma, LCV/176 Parbati Barman, CV/ Ramanath Barman proceeded to the P.O to work out the source information, at about 14.55 hrs I along with my police team reached at Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28 and, on being identified by the source our police team held raid in the house of Marzina Khatun and managed to apprehended the said person with the help of lady forces and recovered Sixteen (16) bottles of Himalayan gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml, which was containing in a white coloured plastic Bag. On interrogation she disclosed her identification as Marzina Khatun (40 yrs) W/o- Md. Bappa of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling and she admitted that she sell the same to her design customers since long for her wrongful gain. On demand she failed to produce any valid documents or licence in r/o said liquor, accordingly I seized the same viz; 1. Sixteen (16) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml (Total market value RS/- 120 X 16 = Rs 1920/-) from the possession of Marzina Khatun (40 yrs) W/o- Md. Bappa of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling (**seizure and labelled was made between 15:15 hrs to 15.45 hrs**) in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As she violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act, as such I arrested her with the help of LC/1282 Swastika Sharma u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraise her ground of arrest and issued arrest memo in presence of witnesses.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour to take legal action against the arrested Smt Marzina Khatun (40yrs) W/o- Md. Bappa of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling under proper section of law.
