Sir,

In producing here with the one arrested accused Smt Fulu Sahani (42yrs) W/o- Dinesh Sahani of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

Twenty(20) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. (Total market value RS/- 120 X 20 = Rs 2400/-)

I ASI Debasish Das of Siliguri PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge a written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Fulu Sahani (42yrs) W/o- Dinesh Sahani of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 28/06/2022 during the day I received a source information at about 15.25 hrs from Tikiapara, ward no 28 under Siliguri PS that one Smt Fulu Sahani of Tikiapara, Matangini- II is selling huge quantity of liquor illegally in her house to her design customers since long, for her wrongful gain. The fact was diarized in GD vide Siliguri PS GD No. 1617 dated 28.06.2022. Subsequently, after sharing the information with I/C Siliguri and as per his kind direction, I along with C/971 Sanjoy Roy LC/1295 Swastika Rai, LCV/190 Babit Barman, CV/263 Prasenjit Dey proceeded to the P.O to work out the source information, at about 15.5 hrs I along with my police team reached at Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28 and, on being identified by the source our police team held raid in the house of Fulu Sahani and managed to apprehend the said person with the help of lady forces and recovered Sixteen (20) bottles of Himalayan gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml, which was containing in a white coloured plastic Bag. On interrogation she disclosed her identification as Fulu Sahani (42yrs) W/o- Dinesh Sahani of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling and she admitted that she sell the same to her design customers since long for her wrongful gain. On demand she failed to produce any valid document or licence in r/o said liquor, accordingly I seized the same viz: I. Twenty (20) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml (Total market value RS/- 120 X 20 = Rs 2400/-) from the possession of Fulu Sahani (42yrs) W/o- Dinesh Sahani of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling (**seizure and labelled was made between 16:15 hrs to 16.45 hrs**) in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As she violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act, as such I arrested her with the help of LC/1295 Swastika Rai u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraise her grounds of arrest and issued arrest memo in presence of witnesses.

I therefore pray before your kind honour to take legal action against the arrested Smt Fulu Sahani (42yrs) W/o- Dinesh Sahani of Tikiapara Matangini- II, ward no 28, PS- Siliguri Dist- Darjeeling under proper section of law.
