Sir,

In producing here with the one arrested accused person namely Chittya Saha (65yrs) S/o- Lt. Harilal Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

1. Fourteen (14) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml. (Total market value Rs 120/- X 14 = Rs 1680/-)

I ASI Debasish Das of Siliguri PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge a written complaint against the arrested accused person namely Chittya Saha (65yrs) S/o- Lt. Harilal Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri to the effect that on 30/06/2022 at about 15.35 hrs during my PC mobile van duty (vide Siliguri PS GDE no-1755 dated 30/06/2022) I received a source information from Jalpaimore under Siliguri PS that one person namely Chittya Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, is selling huge quantity of liquor illegally at Jalpaimore at his Tea Shop to his design customers since long, for his wrongful gain. After received the information myself along with ASI Rabin lama, ASI Siben Sarkar, CV/ Prosenjit Dey, CV/ Ramanath Barman proceeded to the P.O to work out the source information, at about 15.45 hrs I along with my police team reached at Jalpaimore and, on being identified by the source our police team held raid in the Tea Shop at Jalpaimore and managed to apprehended the said person and recovered Fourteen (14) bottles of Himalayan gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml, which is containing in a white coloured plastic Bag. On interrogation he disclosed his identification as Chittya Saha (65yrs) S/o- Lt. Harilal Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and he admitted that he sell the same to his design customers since long for his wrongful gain.

On demand he failed to produce any valid documents or licence in r/o said liquor, accordingly I seized the same viz; 1. Fourteen (14) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country spirit each bottle containing 600 ml (Total market value RS/- 120 X 14 = 1680/-) from the possession of Chittya Saha (65yrs) S/o- Lt. Harilal Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri (**seizure and labelled was made in between 15.55 hrs to 16.25 hrs**) in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. As he violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act, as such I arrested him u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraise him the ground of arrest and issued arrest memo in presence of witnesses.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour to take legal action against the arrested person namely Chittya Saha (65yrs) S/o- Lt. Harilal Saha of Tinbati Colony, W/no- 32, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law.
