In producing here with the one arrested accused person namely (1) Naresh Singh (58) S/O- Lt Upendar Singh of Lower Bhanu Nagar, near Kali Mandir, W.No- 43, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following seized articles as per proper seizure list:

- 1) 10 (ten) bottles of "Himalaya Gold" 60 UP country spirit each bottle containing 600 ML.
- 2) 06 (Six) bottles of Mc'Dowells No 1 whisky each bottle containing 180 ML.
- 3) 04 (four) bottles of Sterling Reserve B-7 Whisky each bottle containing 180 ML.
- 4) 02 (two) bottles of Officer Choice deluxe whisky each bottle containing 375 ML.

I, PSI Rantu Haldar of Bhaktinagar PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodged this written complaint against the above noted arrested accused person to the effect that on 02.07.2022 while performing special raid duty under Bhaktinagar PS area vide BKN PS GDE No.81 Dated. 02.07.2022 at about 19.25 Hrs I received source information that the above noted accused person have possessed huge amount of Liquor in his grocery shop Chandal more, under Bhakti Nagar PS for the purpose of selling the same to local customers. Accordingly the information shared before you and as per your kind direction I along with Constable C/1431 Dilip Barman, CVF-614 Sumit kr Roy CVF/ 619 Dharmendra Roy headed towards Chandal more, to verify the veracity of the information. At about 20.05 hrs we reached at Chandal more, and as shown and being identified by the source held raid and apprehended one person who disclosed their identity as noted above. Further maintaining his decency and observing all formalities searched him and recovered huge amount of above noted seized liquor from his possession. On demand he could not produce any valid documents/licence in respect of the recovered liquor. On enquiry the apprehended person admitted his guilt and confessed that he have possessed above noted liquor at his shop for the purpose of selling to his designed customers. He also stated that he have been doing this illegally since long without any valid licence or Documents for their wrongful gain. Accordingly, I prepared seizure list of the above noted articles in presence of witnesses duly sign by the accused as well as witnesses. The seizure made between 20.25 Hrs to 21.05 Hrs. As he has violated the rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act hence I arrested the apprehended accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C appraising him the ground of arrest.

I, therefore pray before your kind honour that a specific case may kindly be registered against the accused person namely (1) Naresh Singh (58) S/O- Lt Upendar Singh of Lower Bhanu Nagar, near Kali Mandir, W.No- 43, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
