Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Ramprasad Das (55) S/O Lt. Chirkut Das of Sahid Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest has been communicated with him.

- 13 (Thirteen) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 500 ml, Total 7.8 liters)
- 04 (four) bottles of Kingfisher Strong Premium Beer (each bottle containing 650 ml, total 2.6 liters)

I, ASI Sajal Das presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 29.06.2022 at 22.35 hrs I received a secret source information that one person namely Krishna Mohan Roy (54) S/O Lt. Rashik Roy of Madani Bazar, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling I/D liquor illegally at his shop at NJP Station area under PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General diary under NJP PS GDE No 1450 dated 29.06.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with CV/116 Rohit Mahato, CV/306 Biswajit Roy and CV/824 Niru Yadav, all of NJP PS, SPC left for NJP Bazar area, PS- NJP to work on the information in hand. At about 22.45 hrs we arrived at NJP Bazar area and as per the plan filed by the source I held raid at the shop of the said accused and managed to apprehend him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is selling I/D liquor at his shop since long for his illegal gain. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his shop. On demand he failed to produce any documents/licence in respect of store/sale the I/D liquor recovered from his shop. Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure list and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 22.55 hrs to 23.25 hrs.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your Lord honour that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused namely Ramprasad Das (55) S/O Lt. Chirkut Das of Sahid Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
