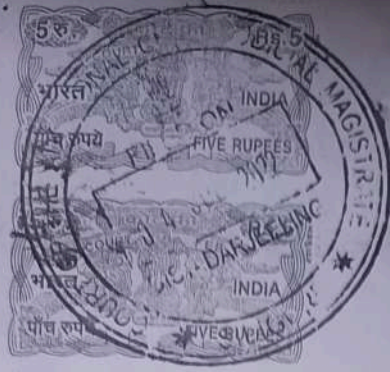

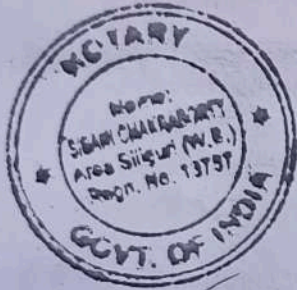

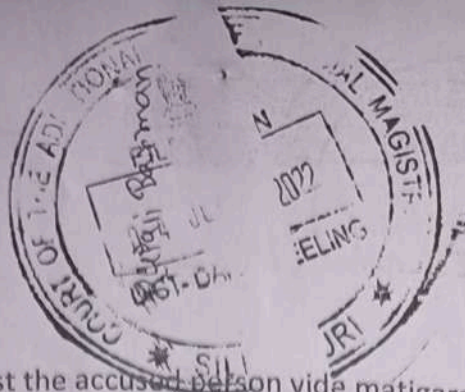

2. That the complainant Rupali Barman was always assaulted by the accused persons for the demand of dowry .
3. that due to this situation the the complainant lodged a written complain before the matigara police station ,on 19/10/2021 and the matigara police satation

started a specific case against the accused person vide matigara ps case no- 1206/21 u/s 498A IPC R/w 3 / 4 of D.P act .

4.that after this case the accused persons came before the complainant and requested her to withdraw the case and the accused person Jalpesh Roy gave a written declaration on non judicial stamp and declared that the accused person jalpesh Roy shall take care of his wife and shall not behave any such manner which is not suitable for her and the said declaration was given in presence of respectable person of the society.(enclosure A ).

5.that accordingly the accused person took the complainant at rented house of Gopal Halde at shivmandir.

6.that in such a way the accused persons convince the complainant to file no objection affidavit before the Ld.ACJM court at siliguri and obtained the bail fraudulently from the L d.court .

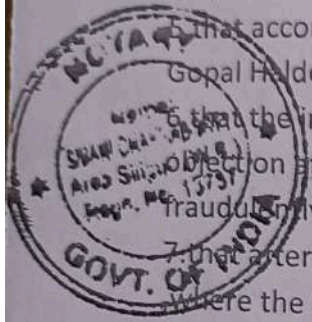
7.that after getting bail the accused person living in rented house at shivmandir where the accused persons again started beating the complainant and toringg her for dowry ,and whenever her husband was a absent brother in law Bharat came to the rented house tried to outraged her modesty and when she inform the mar to her husband who used to beat her .

8.that on 27//03/22 at 1 am Bharat Roy ,and her husband tried to kill her by pressing pillow on her face and tried to kill her by suffocation .

9.that over this incident the complainant lodged a written complain at matigara police station on 6/4/22 but the the matigara police did not start any specific case against the accused persons.(enclosure B).

10.that knowing the fact that the accused persons are high link police did not start any specific case, the compliant lodged a written complain before the commissioner of police but the commissioner of police did not take any step(enclosure C) .

11.That the complainant is the victim of crime and atrocities committed by accused persons , may be in furtherance of their common intention and the averments of the complaint clearly makes out offence of **cruelty and ,attempt to murder** which are cognizable offences and police authorities were required to register the FIR against the accused persons under the relevant section on the complaint lodged by the complainant but due to the high links ,money power and influence of the accused ,the police did not take action against the accused person and only entered the complaint in the 'public complaints register' maintained in the police station..



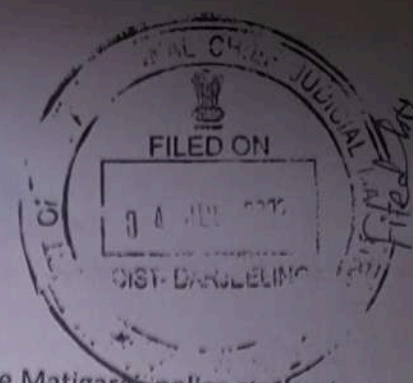

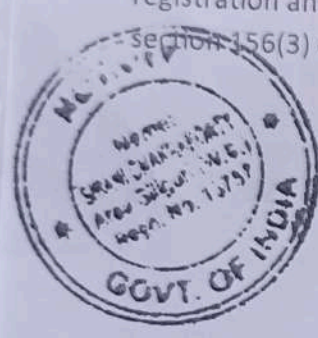

That though under section 154(1) of Crpc the Matigara police station is required to register FIR in respect of receipt of information regarding commission of cognizable offence but in the present, the police has clearly violated the provision of the criminal procedure code by non-registration of the case on the complaint of the complainant despite the fact that same discloses the commission of cognizable offences for which the accused were liable to proceed as per law.

That on account of failure of the police in registration of the FIR, the present application is filed by the complainant for sending the present complaint for registration and investigation of the case to the police station matigara under section 156(3) of crpc.



In view the above detailed facts and circumstances, it is humbly prayed that the present application may kindly be accepted and present complaint may kindly be forwarded for the registration and investigation of the case to the police station matigara .u/s 156(3) crpc and justice may kindly be imparted to the complainant.
