In producing herewith arrested accused person named Mrityunjoy Barman (33), S/O - Late Manindra Barman, of - Kawakhali, Neemtala Ghat, PS - Matigara, Dist - Darjeeling along with copy of memo of arrest, seizure list and seized articles viz (i) 19 (Nineteen) bottles of sealed King Fisher Strong Beer each containing 650 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of Rs. 2280/- marked as exhibit "A" and one bottle taken as sample, & (ii) 07 (Seven) bottles of sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of Rs. 840/- marked as exhibit "B" and one bottle taken as sample, (Totaling amount exhibit A & B, Rs 3120/-).

The fact of the case is that today on 13.07.2022 at 17.05 hrs received source information that one Mrityunjoy Barman, S/O - Late Manindra Barman, of - Kawakhali, Neemtala Ghat, PS - Matigara, Dist - Darjeeling have stored huge quantity of I.D liquor at his Petty shop at Neemtala Ghat illegally for sale to the People for his wrongful gain.

I informed the matter to O/C NBMC OP and as per his direction I along with force, C/131 Kanuram Sarkar, C/ 324 Rupesh Kumar left for Kawakhali Neemtala Ghat to work out the information. At about 17.35 hrs held raid at the petty shop of Mrityunjoy Barman (33), S/O - Late Manindra Barman, of - Kawakhali, Neemtala Ghat, PS - Matigara, Dist - Darjeeling and on search 19 (Nineteen) bottles of sealed King Fisher Strong Beer each containing 650 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of @ Rs. 2280/- & (ii) 07 (Seven) bottles of sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of Rs. 840/- have been recovered. On demand he could not produce any documents / License for his possession such quantity of I.D liquor. On interrogation he confessed that he stored the said I.D liquor illegally for sale to the interested persons for his wrongful gain.

So, I seized the said (i) 19 (Nineteen) bottles of sealed King Fisher Strong Beer each containing 650 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of @ Rs. 2280/- and (ii) 07 (Seven) bottles of sealed Himalayan Gold Bottles 60Up Country Spirit each containing 600 MI Rs. 120/- each totaling amount of Rs. 840/- in presence of witnesses under proper seizure memo and arrested him U/S 41 Cr.P.C.

Under the above circumstances I pray before your kind self that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be initiated against the accused person Mrityunjoy Barman (33), S/O - Late Manindra Barman, of - Kawakhali, Neemtala Ghat, PS - Matigara, Dist - Darjeeling and kindly arranged for its investigation.
