With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Malay Das (40) S/O-Lt. Rabindra Nath Das, of Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS-NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

- (i) 01(One) yellow colour Jar containing total 05 (five) liters of local made illicit liquor (Chullu)
- (ii) 02 bottle of local made illicit liquor (Chullu) containing 2.5 Liter in each Bottle.
- (iii) 05 (Five) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml.)

ASI Sajal Das presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 31.07.2022 at 19.05 hrs I received a secret source information that accused namely Malay Das (40) S/O-Lt. Rabindranath Das, of Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS-NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri is selling ID liquor illegally at his tea stall at Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General Diary of NJP PS GDE No. 1551 dated 31.07.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with HG/794 Ranjit Roy, VP/08 Laxman Roy, all concerned, SPC left for Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to work out the process. SPC left for Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and being identified by the source I held raid at the tea stall of the said accused and managed to apprehended him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as above and also disclosed that he is selling ID liquor at tea stall since long for his livelihood. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his possession under his tea stall. Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 19.35 hrs to 19.50 hrs.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your kind consideration that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the accused namely Malay Das (40) S/O-Lt. Rabindra Nath Das, of Fulbari, Changrabanda, PS-NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
