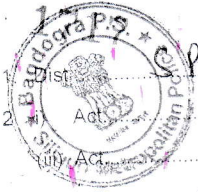

Sir,

I, SI Binup Mahato of Bagdogra PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Suren Tamang (55) s/o Lt. Kaltu Tamang of Station More Rail colony PS Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. Fifteen (15) sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold Country spirit 60 up, each bottle 600 ml, Marked as exhibit-A in which 01 bottle taken as sample for examination exhibit-A1 .
2. Ten (10) Ltrs Local made ID Liquor locally called as " Cholai" which kept in two Plastic Jar each 5 Ltrs Marked as Exhibit -B in which 01 Ltr taken as sample in a Plastic bottle for examination exhibit-B1 .

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today on 06.08.22 at 20-35 hrs received secrete source of information that one person was selling Id Liquor illegally from his house at Station More Rail colony to its customers without any valid license which noted in GD vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 288 dt. 06.08.22. Accordingly the duty officer of Bagdogra PS informed the matter to O.C. Bagdogra PS and as per his instruction myself along with, C/1008 Kanak Roy, CV- 386 Kishor Hawlder CV- 389 Janak Singh, VP-01 Ansalam Kujur left for Station More Rail colony to verify the veracity of information vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 289 dt. 06.08.22 . On arrival at the spot at 21-05 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from his house at Station More Rail colony to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood . On seen the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, On being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses namely (1) Hitesh Sharma (26) s/o Monoj Sharma of Lower Bagdogra, Jâgat Hotel PS Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling and (2) Dipak Biswakarma (35) s/o Lt. Hemlal Biswakarma of Railway Colony PS Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling I recovered 1. Fifteen (15) sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold Country spirit 60 up, each bottle 600 ml 2. Ten (10) Ltrs Local made ID Liquor locally called as " Cholai" which kept in two Plastic Jar each 5 Ltrs from his house at Station More Rail colony from the possession of the apprehended person and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 41 Cr.P.C. as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. This seizure & arrest was made in between 21-25 hrs and 22-05 hrs (seizure Total approx 19 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under proper section of law against the arrested person namely Suren Tamang (55) s/o Lt. Kaltu Tamang of Station More Rail colony PS Bagdogra Dist. Darjeeling and arrange for its investigation.
