Respected Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, Son of Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & SM Power House CCC, empowered by The Electricity Act of India 2003 amended on 2007 do here by lodge this complain for breakage of Transformer & Damage of Property of WBSIEDCL at Jyotinagar, beside Pateshwari School by unknown vehicle. Today at around 09:10 hrs after receiving information on our emergency land line phone number, the undersigned visited the place and found that the 315 KVA Transformer was damaged and oil was leaking massively form Transformer fins. It was learnt from the local people that a vehicle had caused the damage but no one could provide any more details about the vehicle number. The total damaged caused a Financial Loss of WBSIEDCL of around Rs 570000/- (Rupee Five Lakhs Seventy Thousand Only).

Thus you are requested to kindly initiate an investigation & book the culprit under Section 139 of the Indian Electricity act 2003 amended on 2007.
