Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Ganesh Bansfore (38) S/O Lt. Shambhu Bansfore of South Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under arrest and the following articles under seizure. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with him.

- (iv) 13 (thirteen) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP Country Spirit (each bottle containing 600 ml.)
- (v) 04 (four) bottles of Kingfisher Strong Premium Beer containing 650 ML in each Bottle.
- (vi) 03 (Three) paper made pouch of Officer Choice Deluxe Wiskey containing 180 ml. in each pouch.

I, PSI Newton Biswas presently attached with NJP PS under your kind control beg to state that today i.e. on 06.08.2022 at 18.15 hrs I received a secret source information that one person namely Ganesh Bansfore (38) S/O Lt. Shambhu Bansfore of South Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri is selling ID liquor illegally at his shop at South Colony Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in the General diary vide NJP PS GDE No. 307 dated 06.08.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per your kind direction and instruction myself along with CV/306 Biswajit Roy, VP/13 Jamirul Islam all of NJP PS, SPC left for South Colony Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to work out the information in hand. At about 18 35 hrs we arrived at South Colony Bazar, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri, and being identified by the source I held raid at the shop of the said accused and managed to apprehended him. During interrogation he disclosed his identity as noted above and also disclosed that he is selling ID liquor at the shop since long for his illegal gain. On search the above noted I/D liquor recovered from his shop. On demand he failed to produce any documents/licence in respect of store/sale the I/D liquor recovered from his shop. Accordingly, I seized the above noted I/D liquor from his possession under proper seizure list and arrested him under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. The whole process of search & seizure was made in between 19.35 hrs to 20.25 hrs

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your kind honour that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the arrested accused namely Ganesh Bansfore (38) S/O Lt. Shambhu Bansfore of South Colony, P.S- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
