Sir,

I, Suman Sengupta, S/O Ashoke Sengupta, D.E & Station Manager, Power House CCC, WBSEDCL, empowered by The Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India do here by lodge this complain that yesterday at around 13.30 hrs we received a complaint regarding no power at Vishruta Packaging, near lakshmi mela math & Himalaya School, Baikunthapur, Eastern Bypass, P.S Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri. When our L.T maintenance van reached the spot, it was found that the 63 KVA Distribution Transformer was damaged and almost all the transformer oil has been dried out. The financial loss incurred by WBSEDCL for this incident is approximately Rs 11375/- (Rupees Eleven Thousand Three Hundred And Seventy Five Only).

Thus it is requested to initiate an investigation under Sections 136 (1)(a) & 139 of the Electricity Act 2003 amended on 2007 of India against the culprit.
