Sir,

With due respect, I am producing herewith 03 (Three) arrested accused persons namely (i) Md. Raja (30 yrs) S/O Md. Hanif of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling (ii) Raja Das (27 yrs) S/O Niranjan Das of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling and (iii) Pintu Roy(30) S/O-Mantu Roy of Sipahipara, Chaturagang, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, under arrest and 01 improvised small Fire arm (One shooter) measuring 31 cm in length including its 15 CM barrel with one trigger, striking hammer, striking pin in working condition with loaded 01 (one) round live ammunition seized from the possession of accused Md. Raja (30 yrs) S/O Md. Hanif of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling, 01 (one) round live ammunition seized from the possession of accused Raja Das (27 yrs) S/O Niranjan Das of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling, and 01 (one) round live ammunition seized from the possession of accused Pintu Roy(30) S/O-Mantu Roy of Sipahipara, Chaturagang, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri. The ground of arrest duly been communicated with them.

I ASI Sajal Das of NJP PS, SPC do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted 03 (three) arrested accused persons. In this regard, I beg to report that today i.e. on 14.08.22 at 22.25 hrs I received a secret information that three persons came to Micle Madhusudhan colony Railway ground back side of Railway Kendriya vidyalaya under PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri with improvised fire arms and ammunition most probably for committing heinous crime. Accordingly, I diarised the information in General diary vide NJP PS GDE No-696 dated 14.08.2022 and informed the fact to you. As per kind order and direction myself along with VP/13 Jamirul Islam, VP/08 Laxman Roy, HQ/794 Ranjit Roy and CV/306 Bisawajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left Micle Madhusudhan colony Railway ground back side of Railway Kendriya vidyalaya under PS-NJP with investigation kit to work out the information in hand by Govt. vehicle. We reached at the spot i.e. Micle Madhusudhan colony Railway ground back side of Railway Kendriya vidyalaya at about 22.55 hrs and as indicated by the source we able to apprehend three persons. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above. As per source information, that they possessed improvised fire arms and ammunition Hence, immediately I searched the above noted detained persons and found 01 (one) small Fire arm (One shooter) measuring 31 CM in length with one trigger, striking hammer, striking pin with loaded 01 (one) round live ammunition which accused Md. Raja (30 yrs) S/O Md. Hanif of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling, kept concealed in his waist. 01 (One) live ammunition which accused Raja Das (27 yrs) S/O Niranjan Das of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling kept in the left pocket of his full pant, and 01 (One) live ammunition which accused Pintu Roy(30) S/O-Mantu Roy of Sipahipara, Chaturagang, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri kept in the left pocket of his full pant. They exclusively possessed improvised fire arm and live ammunition illegally. On demand they failed to produce any document in support the said improvised fire arm and live ammunition which has been found from their possession. Thus when their involvement in carrying and possessing illegal fire arm and live ammunition was established, I seized that improvised loaded fire arms and 02 (two) rounds of live ammunition under proper seizure list duly signed by them as well as by available witnesses between 23.15 hrs to 00.05 hrs on 15.08.22 and arrested them by preparing memo of arrest informing them about the ground of arrest.

Under the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles there is strong reason to believe that the accused persons namely (i) Md. Raja (30 yrs) S/O Md. Hanif of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling (ii) Raja Das (27 yrs) S/O Niranjan Das of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling and (iii) Pintu Roy(30) S/O-Mantu Roy of Sipahipara, Chaturagang, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, are desperate and dangerous in nature, as they were carrying the said fire arm and ammunition with an objective to commit heinous crime in the locality.

As they have willfully violated the regulation of Arms Act, So, I pray before you for starting a case against the arrested accused person namely (i) Md. Raja (30 yrs) S/O Md. Hanif of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling (ii) Raja Das (27 yrs) S/O Niranjan Das of Tulshinagar, Kolai Basti, PS- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling and (iii) Pintu Roy(30) S/O-Mantu Roy of Sipahipara, Chaturagang, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri, under appropriate section of law and arrange for its investigation.
